### Together We Proclaim Jesus "Emotional Healing"

## <u>Luke 4:17-21</u> - NKJV

<sup>17</sup> And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

<sup>18</sup> "The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to *the* poor; He has sent Me <u>to heal</u> the <u>brokenhearted</u>, To proclaim liberty to <u>the captives</u> And recovery of sight to *the* blind, *To* set at liberty those who are oppressed;
<sup>19</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."

<sup>20</sup> Then He closed the book, and gave *it* back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him.

<sup>21</sup> And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

## *Emotion* is the greatest power there is in the universe.

## **Closet bondage-things -**

- We never will allow anyone to see our hurt's, habit's, or hang-ups.
- Therefore we hide our hurts...
- Healing can never take place.

3 out of the 5 things Jesus laid out for himself to do, deal with the mental side of things.

- **<u>Brokenhearted</u>**-to completely break
- Captives-prisoner of war
- **<u>Oppressed</u>**-crushed

Physical infirmities we can live with and still have joy, but <u>never can our</u> <u>emotions be destroyed</u> and <u>joy continue to reside</u>.

Physical infirmities are much easier to deal with and to learn to live with.

The interior anguish is easier to hide, but <u>harder to live with</u> within yourself.

*God has a special touch* for people who have been <u>battered</u>, <u>torn</u>, and <u>abused</u> *by life's perplexities.* 

Jesus knows right where we are at right now!

### Hebrews 4:15 - NIV

<sup>15</sup> For we <u>do not have</u> a high priest **who is unable to empathize** <u>with our</u> <u>weaknesses</u>, but we have one <u>who has been tempted</u> in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

### He <u>knows</u> our

- Fears Feelings Frustrations
- Hurts Habits Hang-ups
- Anxieties Problems
- Even the number of hairs on our head GOD KNOWS

### He accepts us just the way we are!

## <u>Ecclesiastes 4:1</u> – NIV

**4** Again I looked and saw <u>all the oppression</u> that was taking place under the sun:

I saw the <u>tears of the oppressed</u>— and they have <u>no comforter;</u>

power was on the side of their oppressors — and they have no comforter.

- **Tears** of the oppressed
- The oppressors had **<u>power</u>**.
- The oppressed had <u>no comforter</u>.

# The devil's most powerful tool is <u>DECEIT</u>!

### <u> Psalm 10:7-10</u> - NKJV

<sup>7</sup> His mouth is full of cursing and <u>*deceit*</u> and oppression; Under his tongue *is* trouble and iniquity.

<sup>8</sup> <u>He sits in the lurking places</u> of the villages; In the secret places he <u>murders the innocent</u>; His eyes are secretly fixed on the helpless.
<sup>9</sup> He lies in wait secretly, as a lion in his den; He lies in wait to catch the poor; He catches the poor when he draws him into his net. <sup>10</sup> So he crouches, he lies low, <u>That the helpless may fall by his strength</u>.

The most common lie from the devil is that <u>no one cares</u> and <u>no one</u> understands.

- Even if you told someone, they would not believe you....
- It is so hard for you to even believe in the comforter - -
- You feel like <u>no one can comfort you</u>!!!!

### But the Comforter has come!

HE KNOWS AND HE CARES!

**NIV** - <sup>18</sup> "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news *(to preach the gospel)* to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners (to heal the brokenhearted) and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free,

to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

### **3 MAIN THINGS CAUSE MENTAL ANGUISH**

- 1. Fear- either of failure, of what someone will do to you, fear of fear
  - Fear is faith in the enemy.
  - Fear will drive people insane, you become afraid of everything.

### <mark>2 Timothy 1:7</mark> - NKJV

<sup>7</sup> For God <u>has not</u> given us a spirit of <u>fear</u>, but of <u>power</u> and of <u>love</u> and of a <u>sound mind</u>.

### <u>Fear</u> is of the devil!

2. Abuse- physical, mental, sexual, or verbal.

### The abuse

- Is not your fault!
- Was not your fault
- **<u>Cannot</u>** be fixed or wiped away by your <u>continual beating of yourself</u>

<mark>Isaiah 42:3</mark> - NKJV <sup>3</sup> A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax (WICK) He will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth.

Jesus would rather heal than break, and ignite than to quench.

## 3. Guilt- the blood covers all of our sin.

## Isaiah 64:6 - NIV

<sup>6</sup> All of us have become like one who is unclean, and <u>all our righteous acts</u> are like filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.

The very best that you could do - cannot compare to the holiness of God.

## Psalm 103:12 - NIV

<sup>12</sup> as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

### Calvary still works and the blood still flows!

## WE MUST OVERCOME OUR PAST

# 2 Samuel 12:18-23 - NIV

<sup>18</sup>On the seventh day the child died. David's attendants were afraid to tell him that the child was dead, for they thought, "While the child was still living, he wouldn't listen to us when we spoke to him. How can we now tell him the child is dead? He may do something desperate."

<sup>19</sup> David noticed that his attendants were whispering among themselves, and he realized the child was dead. "Is the child dead?" he asked.

"Yes," they replied, "he is dead."

<sup>20</sup> Then David got up from the ground. After he had washed, put on lotions and changed his clothes, he went into the house of the LORD and worshiped. Then he went to his own house, and at his request they served him food, and he ate.

<sup>21</sup> His attendants asked him, "Why are you acting this way? While the child was alive, you fasted and wept, but now that the child is dead, you get up and eat!"

<sup>22</sup> He answered, "While the child was still alive, I fasted and wept. I thought, 'Who knows? The LORD may be gracious to me and let the child live.' <sup>23</sup> But now that he is dead, why should I go on fasting? Can I bring him back again? I will go to him, but he will not return to me."

## David

- Should have been fighting
- Saw a naked woman bathing
- Lusted Called for her Adultery & baby
- Murder
- 9 months go by Birthing Death
- Fasted & prayed while the baby was still alive
- Perceived the child was dead
- Arose Anointed himself Changed apparel
- Worshipped Ate food

### 6 steps to <u>overcoming</u> your past

- 1. Arise- get up and leave the place where you are at, surroundings play a major role in you thought process
- 2. Washed- cleansed himself from all of the dirtiness of the past.
  - Not only should we leave all of our belongings or trappings behind us.
  - Laying aside every weight & sin...
- 3. Anointed himself-
  - Reminded himself of the first anointing
  - That God had placed on him
  - <u>Renewed his belief</u> in the supernatural
- 4. Changed apparel-
  - Left garments of the past in the past
  - Old things are passed away...

- 5. Worshipped- God is always worthy of worship no matter what
  - Also *thankfulness* was bursting in his heart
  - Because of *mercy*
- 6. Ate food- started his new life immediately
  - *Never stop* to remember
  - Just go on!!!!!!!!!!!

# <u>CLOSE</u>:

Only by <u>our repentance</u> and <u>turning away from our sin</u> will <u>the past</u> <u>lose control on our lives.</u>

## <u>Isaiah 38:17</u> - NIV

<sup>17</sup> Surely it was for my benefit that I suffered such anguish. In your love you kept me from the pit of destruction; you have put all my sins behind your back.

## We <u>do not</u> have to live under <u>the load of guilt</u>.

## No matter:

- <u>What</u> you have done <u>Who</u> you did it with <u>How</u> low in sin you may have went
- <u>After repentance</u> *it is under the blood*, <u>never</u> to be remembered again!!!!!!!
- *Peace, hope, and joy* in the Holy Spirit can be yours today!
