³⁴ "A new command I give you: **Love one another**. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵ By this **everyone will know that you are my disciples**, **if** you **love one another**."

This week - <u>You</u> Matter To Him

<u>Matthew 4:18-22</u> – NKJV - Four Fishermen Called as Disciples

¹⁸ And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called <u>Peter</u>, and <u>Andrew</u> his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ Then He said to them, "**Follow Me**, and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ *They immediately left their nets and followed Him*.

²¹ Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, <u>James</u> *the son* of Zebedee, and <u>John</u> his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. He called them, ²² and *immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him*.

Peter, Andrew, James and John were fisherman.

- Their <u>fathers</u> were fisherman.
- Their grandfathers were probably fisherman.

In these days you inherited your trade from your father.

• Who you were and what you did with your life usually was defined by what family you were born into.

So, we want to focus for just a few minutes <u>on these four quys</u> Peter, Andrew, James and John.

- Maybe they loved fishing.
- Maybe they loved *waking up way before the sun came up*.
- Maybe they enjoyed having to <u>compete with the other fishermen</u> for the best places to fish.

- Maybe they enjoyed the <u>untangling and mending broken nets</u>.
- Maybe they enjoyed <u>cleaning fish</u>.
- Maybe they enjoyed <u>the smell of fish</u>.
- Maybe their **wives** enjoyed their husbands smelling like fish.
- Maybe they enjoyed the small wages of being a fisherman
- Maybe they enjoyed sometimes <u>catching absolutely nothing</u>.
- Maybe they enjoyed all of that <u>but I doubt it</u>.

How many of you absolutely *love your job*?

- A recent Gallup poll found that <u>70 percent of American workers are</u> <u>disengaged</u> from their jobs.
- Of the <u>100 million people who hold jobs in America</u>, the survey found that <u>30 million are actively engaged</u>, <u>50 million are not engaged</u> and <u>20 million are actively disengaged</u>.

Other words,

- 30 percent <u>like their job</u>
- 70 percent don't like their job
- And of those, 20 percent absolutely hate their job

<u>I believe that</u> Peter, Andrew, James and John were probably either one of the 70 percent <u>who didn't really like their job</u> all that much or possibly even one of the 20 percent <u>who actually hated their job</u>.

- After all, *it didn't take a whole lot of convincing from Jesus* to get them to drop their nets
- Walk away from the family business
- And even leave their fathers with the job of doing it all by themselves.

Take a look at Matthew 4:20 – NKJV²⁰ They immediately left their nets and followed Him.

These guys **couldn't wait** to get off of that boat.

- They didn't <u>bat an eye</u>.
- They didn't <u>say "goodbye</u>".
- They didn't <u>offer a resignation</u>.
- *Immediately*, they got off of their boats.

And here's why they were <u>so willing to drop the family business</u> and <u>leave</u> <u>their father</u>s **with the broken nets**...

- They understood and realized *a better opportunity when they saw it* and <u>they weren't going to let anything stand in the way of that</u> <u>opportunity</u>.
- They realized *that their life had a higher purpose*.
- Jesus told them, "I'm going to make you into fishers of MEN.
- Not <u>stinking old fish</u>.

I'm going to *cause your life to have meaning*

- Beyond the <u>slime</u> The <u>fish guts</u> The <u>scales</u> The <u>broken nets</u>
- The storms on the sea
- Late nights and the fruitless labors.

He said, your life *is about to change*.

- Everything they said you would be *is about to be erased*.
- Your past? It no longer is going to *determine your future*.
- Who you were before **is not** <u>who you're going to be</u>.
- It **doesn't matter** who your daddy was.
- It **doesn't matter** what was <u>prearranged for you</u>.
- The <u>stink</u>
- The <u>slime</u>
- The junk that was predetermined for your life...
- It no longer <u>has a hold on you</u>.

How many of you know I'm not really talking about the jobs we have???

• What we are really looking at *is the life we live*.

It really is something *what people can get used to* and *even comfortable with*.

- "I'm this way because *I grew up this way*."
- "I do this because *my daddy did this*."
- "I act this way because *that's how my family acts*."
- It's <u>generational</u>!!!!!!!!!!!

Jesus told these 4 young men, *"I'm going to elevate your status."*

• I'm going to <u>use your life to do something</u> that <u>no one in this world</u> *would have ever imagined from you*.

You were just the fishermen's kids...

- People said you'd never accomplish much.
- All you were good for was <u>mending nets and cleaning fish</u>
- But I'm going to use you to *raise up a church that will change the world forever*.
- You are about to make more of a difference on this world and the future generations than any man or woman has in its history.
- When they say **My name**, *they will also say your name*.
- When they talk about Jesus, they are also going to talk about Peter, Andrew, James and John
- You Matter!!!!!!!!!

People are going to listen to what you say from now on.

- They will <u>read your writings</u> all over the world for thousands of years
- You may <u>not matter to them right now</u>, but *because you matter to me*, <u>the world will find out</u> **what your truest potential really is.**

His call to them was simple... "Follow Me!"

- "Stop doing what you are doing and Follow Me!"
- "Lay down the nets." "Put down the fish."
- "Set aside who you were before and follow me."

Your <u>pas</u>t is <u>no longer</u> your <u>present</u>.

- You thought you were going to be <u>tied to all that stuff</u>.
- You thought you would <u>never escape it</u>
- You thought it would *define who you were going to be* and *who your children were going to be*.

But Jesus said He has a new identity for you.

- You're about to go through a *Spiritual transformation*.
- In fact, Simon, I'm even going to change your name!
- From now on they'll call you Peter.
- "The Rock" (Petra) (Equal authority of God)

See a rock doesn't mean too much if you're a fisherman, but <u>it means a</u> whole lot if you're going to be <u>a cornerstone in the church</u>.

- It means a lot if you're going to be *involved in ministry*.
- It means a lot <u>if you want God to use your life</u> and **give you some** focus and direction.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u> - NKJV

¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone *is in Christ*, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all

The NLT puts it this way...

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u> (NLT) This means that anyone who <u>belongs to Christ</u> has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

Our series this month is entitled <u>You Matter</u>.

- Part of our <u>appreciating that we matter to Him</u> is **understanding that He has a plan for our lives.**
- He has <u>a purpose</u>.
- He has <u>a higher calling</u>.

I hope you understand that what I am saying <u>is not</u> that <u>Jesus wants us all</u> to quit our jobs and <u>become preachers</u>

- But I do believe that <u>we need to understand that</u> we are not defined by our circumstances.
- That we are not <u>defined by our pasts</u>.
- In spite of our pasts
- In spite of <u>where we've been</u>.
- In spite of what we look like.
- In spite of <u>our education</u> or lack of education.
- **Regardless if we are** <u>a doctor</u> or <u>a business man</u> or <u>a fisherman</u> whose out all night long trying to earn a living –
- God has a higher purpose for your life and <u>what you are</u> or <u>where</u> you are right now.
 - You matter to Him
 - You have <u>purpose to Him</u>
 - You are valuable to Him
 - He has plans for your life!

<u>2 Timothy 1:9</u> - NKJV

⁹ who has <u>saved us</u> and <u>called us</u> with a holy calling, not according to our works, <u>but according to His own purpose</u> and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,

- Long before <u>you showed up on this planet</u>, <u>Jesus had a purpose for</u> your life.
- Long before <u>you ever made a decision to follow Him</u>, <u>He had His eyes</u> <u>on you.</u>
- Long before <u>you ever gave your heart to Him</u>, <u>His Grace was at work</u> <u>to bring salvation</u> and <u>a new life to you</u>.

You see, You Matter to Him.

- You might be miserable in your life right now, but understand,
- You Matter to Him!!!!!!
- You might not like the stuff in your life.
- But <u>You matter to Him.</u>
- You might feel worthless, but <u>He has purpose for your life</u>, even <u>a</u> <u>high calling</u>.
- You might feel insignificant
- You might feel like your life is meaningless
- Or even pointless,
- But *<u>He has a purpose</u>!!!!*

<u>1 Peter 2:9</u> - NLT

But you are not like that, for <u>you are a chosen people</u>. You are royal priests, a holy nation, <u>God's very own possession</u>. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for <u>he called you out of the darkness</u> into his wonderful light.

I Like that... "God's very own possession."

• You Matter to Him!

And *here's the calling on our lives*.

Here's the purpose He has given us...

• "To show others the goodness of God."

You Have Purpose – You're special.

- Your life can <u>make a difference</u>.
- You were born <u>with a purpose</u>.
- Fulfill that purpose and **you will find the will of God**.

- God wants to use you!!!!
- Your past doesn't define you.
