• So that we can <u>live successful and productive</u> lives now.

Hardships are a necessity in life

• Of which we must find joy in, otherwise we will not be victorious.

<u>James 1:2-4</u>

²<u>Consider it pure joy</u>, my brothers and sisters, <u>whenever you face trials</u> of many kinds, ³ because you know that <u>the testing of your faith produces perseverance</u>. ⁴Let perseverance finish its work so that <u>you may be mature and complete</u>, not lacking anything.

How many of us really take this verse seriously?

If we really desire the liberating power of God's Spirit in our lives

- We must <u>find joy</u> in life's hardships.
- The point is <u>when facing pain</u>:
- <u>Don't pretend</u> to be happy,
- but to have a positive outlook!!!!

There are a number of things that cause hardship in our lives

 Things such as <u>sicknesses</u>, <u>family tragedies</u>, <u>out of work</u>, <u>financial</u> <u>difficulties</u>, <u>family problems</u>, <u>major calamities</u> like <u>earthquakes</u>, <u>floods</u>, <u>business failure</u>.

These things are a given, but Jesus says,

- "Consider it pure joy"
- He is saying that we must learn how to find joy -
- In the midst of life's hardships !!!!!!!!!!
- Positive-Outlook!!!!

<mark>John 16:33</mark>

"I have told you these things, so that <u>in me you may have peace</u>. In this world <u>you</u> <u>will</u> have trouble. But take heart! <u>I have</u> overcome the world."

Hardships and trials are necessary in our lives.

- <u>The Storms</u> of Life Help to <u>Keep Us on Track With God.</u>
- 2. <u>It Takes Hardship</u> for God's Kingdom to Fully Emerge in Our Lives.
- 3. <u>Struggles and Hardships</u> Sift Out the Impurities in Our Lives.

***HOW TO <u>FIND JOY</u> IN THE MIDST OF HARDSHIP

With this in mind let's look at some of the kingdom principles of faith as to how we can - - -

- <u>Successfully</u> with <u>JOY</u>
- Draw water from the wells of salvation in times of <u>difficulty</u>.

Isa. 12 This chapter is a hymn of praise – another graphic description of *the people's joy* when Jesus Christ comes to reign over the earth....

Isaiah 12:2-3 - Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord himself, is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation."
³ With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

Even now we need to <u>express</u>, Our <u>gratitude</u> to God....

• <u>Thanking him, praising him, telling others about him....</u>

We Must <u>Completely</u> Let Go Of The Past

Philippians 3:13

Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: **Forgetting what is behind** and straining toward what is ahead!

Paul is saying here that - **His goal** is <u>to know</u> **Christ**, to <u>be like</u> **Christ**, and <u>to be all</u> **Christ** has in mind for him.

• This goal <u>absorbs all</u> of Paul's energy.

Until I am <u>really free</u> from the past

• I will never have the joy needed to deal with today's problems & trials!

Paul recognized the <u>weight of the past</u> was a great <u>hinderance</u> to him

- So he <u>let it go</u>.
- We must <u>do the same</u>.
- <u>We must let go of the past</u>
- Before the joy and hope of the future can really settle in.

Paul had reason to *forget* what was behind –

- (As Saul) He had held the coats of those who had stoned Stephen
- The First Christian Martyr

We <u>all</u> have done things for which we are ashamed

- We live in the tension of what we have been
- And what we want to be.

Because our hope is in Christ

- We can let go of past guilt...
- Look forward to what God will help us become!!!!

Realize that you are FORGIVEN

- Then move on to a life of *Faith and Obedience*...
- A meaningful life because of your HOPE in Christ ©

We Must Have A <u>Vision</u> That Is <u>Greater Than</u> The Struggle

Proverbs 29:18 – KJV

¹⁸ Where there is <u>no vision</u>, <u>the people perish</u>: but he that keeps the law, happy is he.

It is vision that sustains us in the midst of life's hardships

- It gives us the ability to <u>see beyond that which is taking place in our lives</u> <u>momentarily.</u>
- It enables us not to lose heart in the midst of the problem.
- What we are going through is only a **momentary** affliction.

<u>2 Corin. 4:16-18</u> – ¹⁶ Therefore we do not lose heart. <u>Though outwardly we are</u> wasting away, **yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day**.

¹⁷ For our light and <u>momentary troubles</u> are achieving for us <u>an eternal glory</u> that far outweighs them all.

¹⁸ <u>So we **fix our eyes** not on what is seen</u>, <u>**but on what is unseen**</u>, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

- Don't forsake your eternal reward - -
- Because of the intensity of today's pain
- Your weakness
- <u>Allows the resurrection power of Christ</u> - to <u>strengthen</u> you !!

Our troubles should not diminish our Faith !!!!!!

• Realize that **there is a purpose** in our **suffering**....

Problems and human limitations have several benefits:

- 1. They remind us of <u>Christ's suffering for us</u>
- 2. They keep us from pride
- 3. They cause us to look **beyond** this brief life
- 4. They prove **our Faith** to others
- 5. They give <u>God</u> the opportunity to demonstrate <u>his Power</u>

See your troubles as opportunities!

The example of <u>Joseph</u> – Genesis 37:5-11.

Joseph is a good example of a person who experienced his share of hardships.

- His brothers hated him because of his dreams, (Kill the dream)
- They sold him into slavery, (Bind him up)
- He was put into prison for something he didn't do and (Falsely accused)
- Yet in *all* of this he was able to find joy!!!!!

The reason was because *he had a vision that was <u>greater than</u> any of the <u>struggles</u> he was going through.*

Genesis 39:22 – In Egypt – The warden knew, <u>The Lord was with Joseph</u>!!! Vs 22 - So the warden <u>put Joseph in charge</u> of all those held in the prison, and he was made responsible for all that was done there. Because of his unwavering attitude of joy in the midst of difficulty - - -

- Joseph saw his dreams come to fulfillment.
- Joseph had <u>some **choices** he had to make</u>.
- He could have taken on a victim mentality by feeling sorry for himself.
- He could have gotten <u>bitter</u> towards those who had <u>done him wrong</u>
- <u>Or</u> he could <u>find joy</u> in the <u>difficulty</u>!

Genesis 50:20 – Speaking to his brothers after his father's death

Vs 20 You intended to harm me, **but** <u>God</u> intended it for good <u>to accomplish what</u> is now being done, the saving of many lives.

- **God** brought good from <u>the brother's evil</u> deeds
- Potiphar's wife's false accusations
- The cupbearer's <u>neglect</u> AND The 7 years of <u>famine</u>

Joseph's experiences in life taught him - - -

• That <u>God</u> brings <u>good from evil</u> for those who trust him.

DO YOU trust God enough to wait patiently

• For him to bring good out of bad sittuations?????

You can trust him because, as Joseph learned

 God can overrule people's <u>evil intentions</u> - And bring about <u>HIS</u> intended results!

We Must Focus On <u>The Growth</u> That <u>God Desires</u> To Bring Forth

God has always desired to <u>use</u> the hardships in our lives

- To teach us to rely on <u>Him</u>
- To use them as an opportunity for growth and maturity.
- Our growth and maturity comes out of the hard lessons of life
- <u>NOT</u> the easy ones!

Romans 5:3-5

³ Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵ And hope does not put us to shame, because <u>God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit</u>, who has been given to us.

Paul tells us that in the future <u>WE WILL</u> become

But until then we MUST OVERCOME....

- This means we will <u>experience difficulties</u> that <u>help us GROW</u>!!
- We rejoice in suffering **NOT** because **we like pain** or **deny it's tragedy**
- But because, we know God is using *life's difficulties*
- And Satan's attacks to build our Character.. GROWTH!!!!

The problems that we run into will *develop our perseverance*

- Which in turn will *strengthen our character*
- *Deepen our trust* in God
- And give us greater **confidence** about *our future*

Thank God for those opportunities to GROW

• Your patience will be tested daily at times, Thank Him for the GROWTH !!

<u>Illustration</u>: *Handling the Bumps*

I was driving down a bumpy country road when <u>I saw a bag of cement</u> beside the road. It appeared to have fallen off a truck as it hit one of the **bumps in the rough road.** Being a person who does not like to see anything wasted, <u>I stopped to pick up the lost bag of cement</u>. When I reached down to pick up this heavy bag, to my surprise, <u>I discovered it was not soft and limber</u>, as I had expected but had solidified into an <u>immovable piece of cement</u>.

Often our lives are like that bag of cement. They <u>take on shapes that were not</u> <u>intended and become hardened in that shape</u>. That bag of cement was meant to become a part of some beautiful structure but, because it did not reach its place of service, <u>it became a useless rock</u> in the form of a bag of cement. <u>God wants to</u> <u>make something beautiful of your life</u>. **Don't let this purpose be thwarted by a bump in the road of life.**

Often times, **when trouble comes**, our <u>natural tendency is to focus on self</u> and <u>the</u> <u>problem and to turn inward which only leads to losing our joy</u>. As a result we develop a <u>survival mentality</u> rather than an <u>overcoming mentality</u>.

<u>The overcoming mentality is what leads to spiritual growth and maturity in the</u> <u>Lord as well as success in our lives</u>. GROWTH!!!!!!!!

We Must <u>Trust In The Lord</u> In All Things

<u>Psalms 5:11-12</u>

¹¹ But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, <u>that those who love your name</u> may rejoice in you.
 ¹² Surely, Lord, you bless the righteous; <u>you surround them with your favor</u> as with a shield.

Our ability to continually trust in God

- Is a very strong <u>key element</u> in our ability to <u>find joy</u> in the midst of life's hardships,
- Because <u>trust enables us to know</u> deep within <u>our heart and soul</u> that everything is really alright.
- It enables us <u>not</u> to get anxious. <u>Trust</u>!!!!!

<u>Psalms 37:3-4</u> –

³ <u>Trust in the Lord</u> and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture.
 ⁴Take delight in the Lord, and he will <u>give you the desires of your heart</u>.

To commit ourselves to the Lord means – *Entrusting everything*

- Our lives, families, jobs, possessions,
- To **HIS control** and guidance....

To commit ourselves to the Lord means to TRUST IN HIM

- Believing that *he can care for us better* Than we can ourselves!!!!!
- We need to wait patiently for him to work out what is best for us!!!!!

<u>Philippians 4:4-7</u> –

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.

⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

- God's peace is different from the world's peace
- **True peace** <u>comes from</u> knowing **(AND Trusting)**that God is in control.
- Let God's peace guard your heart against anxiety!!!! (a feeling of worry,)

<u>Psalms 125:1</u>

Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever.

- The secret to consistency is to **trust in God.**
- Because **HE** <u>never</u> changes
- He cannot be shaken by the changes in our world
- He <u>endures</u> forever....
