## Making a Determined Effort Faith and Spiritual Warfare

In this message I want to talk about *the importance of <u>making a determined</u>* <u>effort</u> in <u>everything</u> that <u>we are involved in</u>, **both** <u>spiritual</u> and <u>natural</u>.

*Determination* is a necessary part of our **spiritual warfare** & our **walk with the** Lord. We will <u>not</u> endure to the end <u>without it</u>.

You can have plenty of <u>vision</u>, <u>insight</u> and <u>purpose</u>, but <u>without determination</u> you *will not* get the job done.

## When your vision and purpose fail,

• Your determination *must* kick in to keep you going *in the midst of* doubt and uncertainty.

\*The difference between the <u>impossible and the possible</u> lies in a person's <u>Determination!!!!</u>

### <u>Proverbs 4:23-27</u> - NIV

23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

24 Keep your mouth free of perversity; keep corrupt talk far from your lips.

25 Let your eyes look straight ahead; fix your gaze directly before you.

26 <u>Give careful thought</u> to <u>the paths for your feet</u> and be steadfast in all your ways. 27 <u>Do not</u> turn to the right or the left; <u>keep your foot from evil</u>.

#### **Determination Definition:**

Determination is the inner fortitude and strength of Character – <u>being disciplined</u> to remain consistent, strong and diligent regardless of the odds or the demands.

- It is the **act of deciding** <u>definitely and firmly</u>, or <u>coming to a resolve</u>.
- Determination is <u>acting in faith</u> - -
- When we **temporarily lose sight** of where we are going.

## Without determination - - -

- We will find ourselves **being tossed** here and there and <u>beat to a pulp</u> when the enemy comes against us.
- When the pressure is on we will find ourselves <u>reacting in a way</u> that is <u>contradictory</u> to what we believe.

## **DETERMINATION** becomes obsession and then it becomes ALL that matters.

We must have the **inner fortitude and strength of character** to remain <u>consistent</u>, <u>strong</u> and <u>diligent</u> *regardless of <u>the odds</u> or <u>the demands</u>.* 

### Determination Is An Important Part Of Our Spiritual Warfare.

### **<u>1 Corinthians 16:13</u> - NIV**

<sup>13</sup> Be on your guard; **stand firm in the faith**; be courageous; be strong.

#### Ephesians 6:13 - NIV

<sup>13</sup> Therefore put on <u>the full armor of God</u>, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able <u>to stand</u> your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

#### The thing that we must realize is

- The devil is making a *determined effort towards us*
- If he is more determined to keep us from moving forward in God
- Than we are <u>he will win</u>.

#### 1. The Example of Manasseh and the Canaanites.

God had given all the tribes of Israel <u>the command to go forth</u> into the promised land and to drive out all of its inhabitants out.

- He not only **commanded them**
- But **promised them** that He would help them.

#### <mark>Joshua 1:9</mark> - NIV

<sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? **Be strong and courageous.** Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your <u>God will be with you wherever you go</u>."

With this promise the <u>children of Israel</u> were to go forth <u>conquering all of the</u> <u>inhabitants of the Promised Land</u>.

We find that **this did not happen** in all cases, **because of the determination** of **their enemies** to continue to dwell in the land.

## <u>Joshua 17:12-13</u> - NIV

<sup>12</sup> Yet the Manassites were not able to occupy these towns, for <u>the Canaanites</u> <u>were determined</u> to live in that region.

<sup>13</sup> However, when the Israelites grew stronger, they subjected the Canaanites to forced labor but <u>did not</u> drive them out completely.

**The reason** the children of Manasseh <u>were not able</u> to drive the Canaanites completely out of the land was because <u>they lacked the determination</u> to do so.

The Canaanites were more <u>determined</u> to stay then the Tribe of Manasseh was to drive them out.

## 2. Through a Determined Effort, We Are to Drive Out Our Enemies.

How many of us <u>give place to the devil</u>, because **we lack the <u>determination</u>** to **completely drive him out of** <u>our lives</u>?

• <u>God has given</u> us **the authority** and **the power** to <u>defeat the enemy</u>.

### <mark>Luke 10:19</mark> - NIV

<sup>19</sup> <u>I have given you authority</u> to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.

We all have strongholds in our lives that <u>the enemy is trying to hold on to</u> with a determined effort.

- The thing that we have to realize is that - -
- We must have more of a **<u>determined</u>** effort than the enemy
- Realizing that greater is He who is in us than he who is in the world.

## <u>1 John 4:4</u> - NIV

<sup>4</sup>You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because <u>the one</u> <u>who is in you</u> is greater than the one who is in the world.

#### The <u>enemy doesn't</u> give up that easily.

- He is **determined**
- So therefore you must realize that **it takes a determined effort** to defeat him.

We are wrestling against - - - THE POWERS OF THIS DARK WORLD!!!

## Ephesians 6:12-13 -NIV

<sup>12</sup> For our struggle <u>is not</u> against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

<sup>13</sup> Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that <u>when the day of evil comes</u>, you may be able to <u>stand</u> your ground, and after you have done everything, to <u>stand</u>. Many <u>Christians *fail*</u> in many areas because *they <u>fail</u> to make a determined effort*.

- <u>Marriages</u>, <u>children</u>, <u>jobs</u>, <u>business</u>, <u>ministry</u>, <u>bondage to sin</u>, and <u>prayer life</u> are areas that <u>the enemy</u> wants to continue <u>to dwell in</u>.
- Are you letting him, simply because <u>he is more determined</u> than you are?

#### Do you have the inner fortitude and strength of character

- To remain <u>consistent</u> <u>Strong</u> and <u>diligent</u> ......
- Regardless of the odds or the demands - -
- That are being **placed upon you** in these areas?

*Without* <u>determination</u> you will find yourselves being <u>beat to a pulp</u> when the enemy comes against you.

When the pressure is on you will find yourselves <u>reacting in a way that is</u> <u>contradictory</u> to what you really believe.

#### <mark>1 Peter 5:8-9</mark> - NIV

<sup>8</sup>Be alert and of sober mind. <u>Your enemy the devil</u> prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

<sup>9</sup><u>Resist</u> him, <u>standing firm</u> in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings.

#### The Kingdom Is Extended Through <u>Determination</u>.

#### The Example Of Solomon Being <u>Determined</u> To Build The Temple.

<u>2 Chronicles 2:1</u> – NIV - Preparations for Building the Temple

**2** Solomon gave orders to build a temple for the Name of the Lord and a royal palace for himself.

The kingdom that was <u>established under Solomon's reign</u> was the **greatest and most glorious of all the kingdoms of the earth**.

- I'm sure that Solomon had his obstacles that he faced along the way.
- But he was determined to complete the task he had been given.
- Regardless of the obstacles set before him!!

We Too <u>Must Be Determined</u> To See The Kingdom Extended.

### Matthew 11:12 - NIV

<sup>12</sup> From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been subjected to violence, and violent people have been raiding it.

*We must make a <u>determined effort</u>* in establishing the kingdom of God in our midst.

*We have <u>experienced</u> many* <u>defeats</u>, <u>setbacks</u>, <u>discouragements</u> and <u>other</u> <u>hindrances</u>, but <u>we must be like the</u> apostle <u>*Paul*</u> who said - - -

<u>Acts 20:24</u> "<u>But none of these things move me</u>; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

## Harold Sherman wrote a book entitled, "How To <u>Turn Failure Into Success</u>." In it he gives a<u>code of persistence</u>.

He says:

- I will <u>never give up</u> so long as I know I am right.
- I will believe that <u>all things will work out</u> for me if I hang on to the end.
- I will be <u>courageous and undismayed</u> in the face of odds.
- I will not permit anyone to <u>intimidate or deter</u> me from my goals.
- I will fight to overcome <u>all physical handicaps</u> and <u>setbacks</u>.
- I will try again and again and yet again to accomplish what I desire.
- I will take <u>new faith and resolution</u> from the knowledge that all successful men and women have <u>had to fight defeat and adversity</u>.
- I will never <u>surrender to discouragement</u> or <u>despair</u> no matter what seeming <u>obstacles</u> may confront me.

- Defeat adversity !!!!

## **<u>1 Corinthians 9:24-27</u> – NIV -** The Need for Self-Discipline

<sup>24</sup> Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? <u>Run in such a way as to get the prize.</u>

<sup>25</sup> Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training. They do it to get a crown that will not last, but <u>we do it to get a crown that will last forever</u>.

<sup>26</sup> Therefore I do not run like someone running aimlessly; I do not fight like a boxer beating the air.

<sup>27</sup>No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.

## <u>WHO CAN STOP YOU????</u>
