The Gospel Rooster

<u>Luke 22</u>

Jesus and his disciples share the Last Supper

Jesus predicts Peter's Denial -

- Satan had asked *to sift Peter* as wheat.... Vs31
- Jesus prayed that **Peter's faith would not fail**. Vs32
- Jesus said <u>WHEN</u> you turn back Strengthen your brothers....

Peter the tells the Lord – I'm ready to go to prison or death with you...Vs33

- Jesus answered, "Before <u>the rooster crows</u> today –
- You <u>WILL DENY three times</u> that you know me!!!"

Jesus predicts Judas would betray him

- **<u>Calamity</u>** awaited the traitor
- Jesus then predicts that *Peter would Deny* that he knew Jesus
- Later, however, **<u>Peter would repent</u>**

Betraying and denying – one is just about as bad as the other

- But Judas and Peter had <u>entirely different fates</u>
- Because *Peter repented.....*

Jesus Agonizes in the Garden

• Judas leads them to arrest Jesus

Jesus then is **Betrayed and Arrested** -

- They seize Him and take him to the high priest' house
- <u>Peter</u> follows <u>AT a distance</u>

<u>A servant girl</u> says – This man was with Jesus

- Peter denies <u>the first time</u> "Woman I don't know him!"
 <u>Someone else saw him</u> You are also one of them
- Peter denies <u>the second time</u>- "Man I am NOT!"
 <u>An hour later another says</u> Certainly this man was with Jesus

<u> Third time</u> Peter Denies - - - - -

<u>Luke 22:60-62</u> - NIV

⁶⁰ Peter replied, "Man, I don't know what you're talking about!" Just as he was speaking, *the rooster crowed*.

⁶¹ The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him: <u>"Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me</u> <u>three times."</u> ⁶² And he went outside and wept bitterly.

The reason we as Christians love to eat chicken is because <u>it was a rooster who</u> <u>told on Peter!</u>

- \Rightarrow So, Christians have been <u>trying to get even</u> with chickens ever since.
- \Rightarrow This Gospel rooster was a fighting rooster that keeps his spurs sharp.
- \Rightarrow He has preached the <u>same message</u> over and over.
- \Rightarrow His message is still read by millions today!
- \Rightarrow I believe he **RULED** his roost.

LET ME GIVE YOU <u>7 Things</u> about this <u>ROOSTER</u>:

 This ROOSTER did <u>what he could do</u>- God never will ask you to do something you cannot do...

What could the rooster do?....

This Rooster Crowed

- \Rightarrow He <u>did not</u> do what he <u>could NOT</u> do.
- \Rightarrow He <u>didn't</u> try to <u>bark</u>, <u>sing</u> like a canary, or <u>roar</u> like a lion!
- \Rightarrow He simply **<u>CROWED</u>**
- ⇒ I believe that every time <u>Peter</u> heard a rooster crow, <u>from that day on</u>, **it** was a reminder to him of the time <u>he missed God</u>.
- ⇒ Every one of us has our own calling. Some are <u>Pastors</u>, <u>Teachers</u>, <u>Evangelist</u>, <u>Prophets</u>, and <u>Apostles</u>.
- <u>This ROOSTERS</u> job was <u>not considered important</u> by the World's Standards

They <u>didn't</u> ruffle his feathers.

- \Rightarrow Some are called to <u>pick up trash</u>
- \Rightarrow Some are called <u>to preach</u>
- \Rightarrow Some all called <u>to sing</u>
- \Rightarrow Some are called <u>to teach</u>
- \Rightarrow Some are called <u>to drive</u>
- \Rightarrow Some are called as <u>missionaries</u>
- \Rightarrow Some are called to <u>be witnesses at work</u>...
- ⇒ <u>NO JOB</u> IS <u>MORE IMPORTANT</u> THAN ANY OTHER!!!

His crowing is <u>NOT</u> highly esteemed by the world. His crowing <u>was common</u> (but <u>didn't stop him</u>). His crowing <u>seemed foolish</u>

<u>1 Corinthians 1:18</u> NIV For the message of the cross is **foolishness** to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved **it is the power of God**.

3. This ROOSTER was not ashamed...and neither should we be!!

Romans 1:16 NIV *I am not ashamed of the gospel*, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.

- ⇒ He had <u>crowed before</u> the Lord used him...now <u>God was using him</u>...
- ⇒ All his crowing <u>didn't embarrass him</u>…*He <u>refused</u> to be ashamed*
- ⇒ His crowing <u>didn't make him **want to quit**</u> because just one person heard him
- ⇒ God doesn't have <u>any small saints</u>...**we are <u>all</u> important!!**
- 4. This ROOSTER was Faithful! He crowed regardless of who listened.
- \Rightarrow He crowed whether he <u>felt like it or not</u>.
- \Rightarrow He crowed <u>rain or shine</u>.
- \Rightarrow He crowed **in season or out of season**

<u>2 Timothy 4:2</u> NIV <u>Preach the Word;</u> be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction.

- 5. This ROOSTER was not popular at all
- \Rightarrow Because he <u>woke sleeping folks</u> up

- \Rightarrow In ministry ... sometime we have to wake sleeping folks up
- \Rightarrow This rooster **woke PETER up...**

6. He never got discouraged...

- \Rightarrow Even if **the old Hens** <u>complained</u>
- \Rightarrow Or the <u>other</u> *roosters* <u>tried to stop him</u>
- ⇒ He <u>didn't</u> look for <u>encouragement</u> from anyone else... *he just did <u>what he</u>* <u>had to do</u>
- \Rightarrow He never <u>talked to anyone else</u> about what to preach.
- ⇒ He just <u>did what he had to do.</u>

His crowing was a lonely job!!!!!

7. This ROOSTER did his job well...

Because he preached what, where, and to whom God wanted him to preach.

- \Rightarrow Even though <u>it condemned</u>
- ⇒ The *rooster* accomplished the task the Lord set before him
- \Rightarrow Because **<u>HE allowed God</u>** to <u>*use him*</u>...

<u>CLOSE:</u> If God can use a ROOSTER...<u>He can use you</u>!!!

If you think that God <u>can't use you</u>...remember how <u>he used the ROOSTER</u> and how about these that God used to preach the gospel?
