The Abundant Life Series #3 Open Windows

Our series *The Abundant Life* and our *focus scripture* for the series is:

John 10:10 - KJV

¹⁰ The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come <u>that</u> they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

So we are trying to understand what Jesus was talking about when He said **that** they might have it more abundantly.

- Today I want to focus on this thought, <u>Open Windows.</u>
- I want to <u>share a scripture</u> with you that I believe will help us here this morning.

Malachi 3:10 - NKJV

¹⁰ Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the <u>windows of heaven</u> And pour out for you <u>such</u> blessing That <u>there will</u> not be room enough to receive it.

This "Spiritual Law" is a promise from God to "open you the windows of heaven,"

- How do we get the "Windows of Heaven" seen in verse 10n opened?
- And how do we keep the "Windows of Heaven" open?
- It's strange to me that the scripture here refers to <u>Windows.</u>
- You **don't** usually pass things **through a window**.

You generally pass things through <u>a door</u>.

• **Doors** are mentioned many times in the scripture.

Revelation 3:20 - NKJV

- **20** Behold, I stand at <u>the door</u> and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens <u>the door</u>, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
- But here in Malachi it mentions Windows.

Let's think about this for a moment.

What is a window used for?

- First of all, <u>it let's light come into a dark place</u> at the due time.
- I like waking up to the light.
- Without the light, you have to <u>fumble around in the darkness</u>.
- You have to <u>create something artificial</u> in order to be able to have some clear vision.

A <u>window</u> does more than bring <u>light</u> into a <u>dark situation</u>.

- It also gives you <u>a view</u> <u>outside of your circumstances</u>.
- You may only be able to see what is happening within your circumstances
- But when you step up to the window
- You will get a **much different view** than what you had before.
- You will get a much <u>clearer</u> understanding of the <u>circumstances that</u> <u>surround</u> and ultimately <u>control your life</u>.

I think of the pioneers back in the day.

- They would wake up in the morning freezing cold.
- The water on the table from the night before would have ice on it.
- They wouldn't understand what was causing the ice if they didn't look out the window to see that winter had arrived.
- The window let them see <u>what season</u> they were in so they knew <u>how to dress</u> and what to do <u>inside and outside</u> the cabin to be able to <u>survive</u> what the window was showing them.

A <u>window</u> does more than show you what is <u>immediately</u> outside

- It also shows you what is *off in the <u>distance</u>*.
- Mountains may be off in the distance.
- Rivers Streams Forests All kinds of <u>opportunities</u> All kinds of possibilities.

Opportunities that other people <u>pass by</u> every single day.

- Options that other people never get to consider.
- **<u>Promises and potential</u>** that people **<u>without open windows</u>** never get a chance to see.

Jesus said when referring to the Pharisees in Matthew 15:14 - NKJV

¹⁴ Let them alone. They are <u>blind</u> leaders of the <u>blind</u>. And if the <u>blind</u> leads the <u>blind</u>, both <u>will fall into a ditch</u>."

- He was referring to religious teachers who could not see all that Jesus was offering to people.
- **Teachers of the scriptures** who themselves <u>had no ability to see</u> the promises of God.
- Jesus said they are like <u>blind people leading blind people</u> and when this happens, they both <u>fall into a ditch</u>.

Why did they fall into a <u>ditch</u>?

- Because there was **no vision**.
- And where there is **no vision**, the people **perish** right?
- And there was especially *no spiritual vision*.

See when Malachi speaks of the Windows of Heaven being opened...

- He is saying that God is going to begin to show you some things that will keep you from falling into the ditch.
- For some people, **that's the light** coming into the room.

I went to a Men's advance years ago...

- I felt stuck (in a ditch) in my life, stuck in my walk with Christ!!!
- I had paid the money for myself and others to attend this retreat and begin to wonder if it was even worth it!!!!
- On the second day and third service, something begun to happen...

As I was sitting with a bunch of other believers God began a new work.

- God began to <u>stir my spirit</u> <u>dance</u> before me....
- As I did <u>I stood in amazement</u> as <u>I watched God</u> work.
- I watched as they *shed some light* on what I already had in front of me.
- They was preaching on the loss of my anointing (The Ax Head).
- About that time our son <u>Randy</u> was <u>miraculously healed</u>...

Wow, God was still God and HE was on the move!!!!

- Not because they were telling emotional stories....
- But because <u>a much needed light</u> was coming in.

Have you ever been in a ditch?

- Has your life ever felt **stuck**?
- Muck and mire is what you find in a ditch.
- Ruts that <u>don't let you climb</u> out are in a ditch.
- Other blind people are in a ditch...
- Complaining about how bad life is in the ditch
- And how hard it is to get out.
- And <u>how many times they've tried</u> to get <u>out of the ditch</u> and <u>failed</u>.

Do You know what you need when you find yourself blind and stuck in a ditch?

- Someone who has some vision to lead you out.
- Someone to <u>tell you the truth</u> about <u>your circumstances</u>, whether you want to hear it or not.
- Someone who will <u>shed some light</u> on <u>your situation</u> so you can see what you need to do to get out of the ditch.

You need some *Heavenly Windows to open* up in your life.

Where <u>light</u> and <u>vision</u> and <u>perspective</u> and <u>insight</u> can enter into your situation.

Abraham is called in the scriptures the Father of the Faithful.

- In fact Hebrews 11 accounts the great faith that Abraham had in God.
- But God had to teach Abraham how to have faith.

Genesis 12:1-3 NKJV - Promises to Abram

12 Now the Lord had said to Abram:

"Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you.

³ I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

² I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing.

Look at that, "Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you.

God told Abraham, <u>I'm going to show you</u> a place I want you to live.

- A place of *promise and possibilities*.
- A place where you and your family are going to be blessed.
- A place of *greatness*
- A place where *curses are going to fall off* your life.
- A place where people are going to go out of their way <u>to bless you</u> and when they do, God said, I'm going to <u>bless them</u>.
- Instead of being surrounded by people who are stuck in a ditch...
- You are going to find yourself <u>surrounded by</u> people <u>who are blessed</u> because of you and your great faith in God!

Instead of hearing all the <u>murmurings of the ditch</u>, you are going to <u>hear the</u> <u>testimonies of people</u> who <u>have had some light and vision</u> come into their life.

- Some people who've <u>had some miracles</u> happen
- Wherever Abraham <u>put his foot</u> <u>he was prospered</u>
- God gave him the land he <u>walked into for an inheritance</u> for his children and their children's children.

<u>Let's look at - Malachi 3:10</u> - NKJV

¹⁰ Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the LORD of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven *And pour out for you such blessing That* there will not be room enough to receive it.

Room enough – That's not just talking about **quantity**

That's talking about <u>space</u> – <u>Area</u> - <u>Capacity</u>

God wasn't just promising us **quantity** in **Malachi 3:10**

• He was promising to **bless us in all** the different **areas** of our life.

^{***}There will not be room enough to receive it. ***

God is inclined to "open you the windows of Heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it."

Verse 11 even tells us that <u>God will involve himself</u> in the success of their crops and vines.

Some people think <u>Malachi 3:10</u> is just talking about **God's blessings on our finances**. - **Quantity... He's not** just talking about **your finances**

James 1:17 – NIV - <u>Every good and perfect gift is from above</u>, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who <u>does not change</u> like shifting shadows.

He's talking about -

- Your <u>home</u> Your <u>marriage</u> Your <u>relationships</u> with other family members
- Your **children**
- Your <u>job</u> <u>Those you work with</u> Those you <u>do business with</u> Those you <u>buy from</u>
- Your church The areas of ministry that you are involved in
- Your time availability to serve other people

Malachi 3:10 doesn't just say "WINDOW"

- God doesn't just promise to *open one window* finances.
- He promises to open "The Windows of Heaven".
- All kinds of areas of your life that He would like to bless you in.
- <u>All kinds of ways</u>.
 - Ways you never <u>imagined before</u>.
 - o Ways you never thought possible.
 - o Ways you never seen other people get blessed.

CLOSE:

So He's going to "pour out a blessing" through

- <u>Windows –</u> multiple views. Plenty of <u>opportunity</u>
- New ways of looking at things Some ways, right up close to you.

They are <u>already available</u> to you, you just need someone to <u>shine a light on</u> them.

How do we get the "Windows of Heaven" opened, and keep them open?

- 1. <u>Keep your heart open!</u> Welcome the Holy Spirit to shine the Light of God's Word in any dark place of your heart.
- 2. <u>Keep your mouth open!</u> Prayers & Praise are natural outcomes of a life that honors God.
- 3. Keep your pocket open! Let God use your finances.
- 4. Keep your hands open! Help others.
- 5. Keep your eyes open! See the need for the lost in the world.

There shall not be room enough to receive it.

- I don't know about you, but I'd like to get to the point where I say, "STOP!"
- I'm too blessed!!!!!!!!!!

Have you been <u>fumbling around in the dark</u>?

- For someone, <u>light</u> is starting to appear.
- You're <u>seeing something</u> you've <u>never seen before</u>.
- A <u>new</u> understanding

One last thought out of Malachi 3:10. Notice the words, "Prove Me..." It simply means that if we will be obedient, God will prove Himself true to His Promises.

Others can't see what you see - But you do!!!!

• Because a *Heavenly understanding* has been *opened to you*.

I'm amazed sometimes how some people <u>can't see what is right in front of</u> them...

• But it's because they are not letting God open the windows of Heaven to them.

I wonder what God has for your life today.

- Right now.
- Something that is **right in front of you** and **you haven't been able to see it**.
- But there it is......
