The Abundant Life #5

A New Normal

Philippians 1:6 - NKJV - ⁶ being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the day of Jesus Christ;

<u>Philippians 1:6</u> – CEV - ⁶ God is the one who began this good work in you, and I am certain that he won't stop before it is complete on the day that Christ Jesus returns.

Define Normal - conforming to a standard; usual, typical, or expected.

We all have a <u>normal</u>....

- *Normal* is <u>how we respond</u> to situations.
- *Normal* is <u>what people expect</u> of us in given parts of our lives.
- Normal is our spiritual condition
- It is our <u>disposition</u>
- It is our <u>character Within our Normal</u> is our expectations of Life.
- It's our dreams
- Our <u>hopes</u> Our <u>desires</u>
- It's what *satisfies us and causes us to be happy*.

<u>Normal</u> - We <u>all</u> have one!!!

- Each of ours is *different*, but in many ways *they are alike*.
- If you could write down on a sheet of paper *"your normal"*, <u>what would</u> <u>it say</u>?

Hopeful? Expecting? Happy? Satisfied? Engaged in Life?

Whatever <u>our normal</u> is, <u>John 10:10</u> tells us that <u>Jesus came to make our normal</u> <u>better</u>. – "<u>I have come</u> that they may have life, and that <u>they may have it more</u> <u>abundantly</u>." - <u>Jesus</u> described it as <u>More Abundant</u>.

I was in Berlin (Amish country) with family to spend the weekend.

- I was talking to the founder of **Hershberger's** and asked how he was.
- He said, *Not Good!* I asked him where he was going for help.
- He did not know. Apparently his world was pretty small.
- He <u>didn't</u> travel <u>much beyond his farm</u>, <u>church</u>, and the <u>businesses</u> he needed to visit there in Berlin.
- He really *could not* tell me about much outside of *Berlin His Normal*.
- It's all he's <u>ever known</u>.
- <u>His religious beliefs</u> and way of life keep him isolated from the rest of the world so *His normal is very different than your normal*.
- Yet, it is His normal, And I'm sure he enjoys his normal.
- It all seemed very <u>simplistic and serene</u> in a way to me actually.

But <u>we are not</u> really talking about <u>where we live</u> or <u>how far we've traveled</u> outside of Berlin.

<u>We are talking</u> about our <u>spiritual condition</u> and God's desire <u>to give us a new</u> <u>normal</u>.

Someone might say, I don't like my normal – Spiritually

- I wish things could be <u>different</u>.
- I wish I could be <u>closer to God</u>.
- I wish *I knew Jesus* on a more personal level.
- I wish my life <u>was different</u>, *I could serve God more*.

I remember as a young man lifting weights.

- We called it our Max.
- What could we <u>Max out</u> at...
- I liked <u>bench pressing</u>.
- I remember when I was very young when my max was 70 pounds.

Upper classmen laughed at me. But hey *that's all I had to give*.

- However, I kept working out and pretty soon my normal changed.
- Pretty soon it was 90 pounds, then 100 then 125 then 150, then 175
- My normal kept <u>increasing</u>.
- My normal kept growing.
- Where I was the week before was not where I was at the next week.

It took a while, but pretty soon, *I was way past my <u>original normal</u>*. Here's where <u>many people trip up</u> *in their walk with God*.

- They think that **normal** <u>has to stay normal</u>.
- That they **<u>can't</u>** grow beyond where they are at.

That they are <u>stuck</u>!!!!!!!!!

- Stuck in life
- Stuck in their walk with God
- Unable to move forward, and trapped right where they are...
- Sometimes for the rest of their life.
- Aren't you glad you know Jesus Christ today?
- Aren't you glad you know the one who came to give us Life
- AND That more abundantly?

There is no one <u>but you</u> who can *put limitations* on you.

Your life is simply that – your life.

- You *control it* You *decide*.
- What you do <u>with your life</u> is up to you.

You can stay in Spiritual Berlin till Jesus comes if you like, Never growing.

- Never maxing out at a <u>new level</u>
- Never going beyond *the boarders* of *where you've already been*.

You can choose <u>a new normal</u>.

- You can decide that today, **something** *is going to change* in your life.
- That *new boundaries* are going happen
- That *new horizons* are going to be reached

That **who you were** this morning when you woke up <u>is not</u> going to be who you are when you go to bed this evening.

Jesus *is not interested in helping people stay where they are.*

If you are comfortable and *not really wanting to* grow spiritually or <u>experience</u> <u>the Abundant Life</u>

- I just want you to know <u>that you probably are not going to be</u> <u>comfortable</u>.
- Jesus <u>doesn't</u> do normal.
- He was *constantly shaking things up* for the religious folk.
- Doing things that for hundreds of years, they never even thought of doing.

In fact they considered it *blasphemy* if you did.

- Healing on the Sabbath, *that's not normal*!
- *Eating and drinking with sinners* who does that?

Very little about Jesus was Normal.

- His birth was <u>not normal</u>.
- His childhood was <u>not normal</u>.
- His adolescence was <u>not normal</u>.
- His ministry was <u>not normal</u>.
- *His death, burial and resurrection* sure *wasn't normal*.
- And yet, that *absence of Normal* is what we hang our hat on *when it comes to salvation.*

<u>Resurrection</u>... Who does that?

- We all know that *without His resurrection*, we have **no hope!**
- But resurrection was not normal!
- Aren't you glad Jesus didn't stick to normal?

We have <u>hope</u> today because Jesus <u>didn't stick to normal</u>.

So why do we think we're supposed to be normal?

Romans 8:37-39 – **NKJV** - 37 Yet in all these things <u>we are more than conquerors</u> through Him who loved us. 38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Now a conqueror is <u>not normal</u>.

- Paul goes on to say that we are "More" than conquerors.
- Other words, if your "<u>Normal" is a conqueror</u>.
- Then vs 37 says that you are "More than conquerors through Him that Loves us."

That's someone whose, *Normal has found <u>a New normal</u>.*

- Someone says, I've found a "new normal"
- Jesus has a "new normal" for your "new normal."

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u> – NKJV - ¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a <u>*new*</u> creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become <u>*new*</u>.

<u>*Philippians 3:14*</u> – NKJV - ¹⁴I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

***<u>Lame man at the Gate Beautiful</u>.

His normal was just laying there.

- But when Jesus healed him... *His normal changed.*
- *<u>He got up</u>*, leaping, dancing and praising God!
- The next morning.... <u>He didn't</u> wake up and just go back to laying around.
- Or begging at the Gate Beautiful.

He Got up!!!!

- Put his own close on.
- Fixed his own breakfast.
- Went looking for a job, a new place to stay, a church to attend...
- Hey, *I'm just supposing*, but you can see it...

His normal Changed his normal which changed His normal

***<u>Adulteress woman thrown at Jesus feet</u>. Jesus saves her life literally by not judging her.

- What do you think happened after that?
- Her <u>normal</u> changed.
- She went and put some clothes on.
- Maybe she moved out of the neighborhood.
- Went shopping for a new wardrobe a few things not so promiscuous.
- Less revealing More modest

Went and poured out all her cologne on Jesus feet.

- Started attending some Bible Studies and church services.
- Went looking for a new profession.
- Started hanging out with a different crowd.

Her Normal Changed!!!

*** CLOSE: Are you ready for a New Normal?

Are you ready for <u>your old person to die out</u> and your <u>new person</u> to come alive <u>with hope and Abundance</u>?

- <u>Lame man</u> at the Gate Beautiful.
- <u>Adulteress woman</u> thrown at Jesus feet.
- THEY GOT UP!!!
- Their Normal CHANGED!!!
