Feelings, the Messengers of Satan

Feelings are real, but they cannot be authoritative!!!!

I am so glad my *feelings have no meaning*.... I am even more grateful <u>they **do not**</u> <u>affect</u> *my salvation* or *my relationship* to the Lord.

I would have given up long ago had I given in to my feelings.

- My feelings have *discouraged me* many times
- They've tried to *deceive me*
- They've tried to *rob me* of **my peace and joy** in Christ
- And they have *harassed and accused me* of every evil thing possible.

I have come to recognize all unsettling feelings as <u>messengers of Satan</u>, intended to bring us down into <u>despair and fear</u>.

I can be walking along in the Spirit, reading <u>my Bible</u>, <u>praying</u> and <u>loving the Lord</u> with <u>all my heart</u>.

Suddenly, unexpectedly:

• I am overwhelmed with *troubled feelings* that flood my mind and spirit.

I did nothing to deserve these evil messengers of Satan.

- It seems as though the wicked principalities and powers of hell....
- Flood me with *unwanted* negative feelings when <u>I least expect them</u>.
- This <u>often happens</u> right after some *great spiritual victory* or *revelation*.

When the enemy comes in like a flood -

- Trying to drown me in *depressing feelings* and *negative thoughts*
- I have a tendency to *blame myself*.

I say to my heart

• Why am I so restless and irritable - when I don't want to be?

What evil thing have I done to deserve these negative, depressing feelings?

Why Do I Feel Like This? - Buffeting

Definition of Buffeting - *the action* of <u>striking someone</u> or <u>something</u> *repeatedly and violently:*

<u>Peace and happiness</u> are suddenly disrupted

- You are cast down into *the pit of despair*...
- Why such a heavy, sad, fearful cloud hanging over me?
- What's wrong –
- <u>Have I</u> brought it upon myself by <u>something I've done</u>."

It <u>doesn't seem to matter</u> how much <u>faith or revelation</u> of truth you may have -There comes to all God's children –

This <u>humbling experience</u> of falling into a <u>dry, depressing time of confusion</u>.

- When it hits you, everything seems distorted for a while.
- An *inexplicable irritability* is the first sign of *this buffeting from Satan*.

As much as you hate it - you will find yourself short tempered

- Cutting off your loved ones and those you work with -
- And perhaps even raising your voice at your husband, wife, or children.

You may then *feel condemned*; you may even feel *sinful and immature*.

You will probably do as I do and end up thinking to yourself -

- How could I feel so low, so weak, so immature -
- <u>So stupid</u> *how did I turn from* <u>hot to cold so quickly</u>?

What's <u>bothering me</u>?

What's making me act so un-Christlike?

If you allow it to happen, *feelings have a way of draining* your confidence in the Lord, and in yourself.

Your feelings, if left unchecked can drag you down into despair and fearfulness.

1. And fear has torment. Your feelings, when in control, will lie to you like the devil himself.

- 2. They will put on you a fear of cancer, fear of dying.
- 3. Fear of losing a loved one and a world of other overwhelming fears.

They (feelings) distort everything you look at.

Perhaps just <u>yesterday</u>, you had <u>marvelous thoughts of</u> God's power and love.

- Your faith was alive with hope
- you encouraged others
- you felt spiritually strong
- truth excited your soul!

But today, just hours later, the picture has changed.

- Maybe the cloud was there when you work up.
- Maybe it crept over you in the middle of the day.

Without warning, <u>without any reason</u> you can think of - **you are** <u>thinking and</u> <u>feeling</u> something entirely different.

To be <u>really honest</u> about it, you feel <u>defeated!</u> You feel <u>down!</u>

- You feel <u>strange</u>! You feel <u>confused</u>! You feel <u>helpless</u>!
- You feel like you <u>haven't learned anything</u> that you are still *a bundle of mistakes!*
- You feel <u>unworthy</u>!
- You feel like you are wasting time!
- You feel unloving!
- You feel dejected!
- You feel misunderstood, forsaken!
- You feel angry that you feel so helpless and blue!
- You feel discouraged because you are still the victim of childish pouting.

You thought you had learned <u>how to handle</u> such <u>crisis in the past</u>, but now you realize there is **so much more to learn about** <u>yourself</u>.

It's so easy to throw around theology and simple formulas and tell people, "You shouldn't feel like that!

- Where is your faith?
- God wants you to live in victory and constant joy!
- You should not be *victimized by feelings* of despair or depression."

My answer to that is this - at times, <u>we experience a low period of</u> unexplained feelings of <u>emptiness</u>... <u>confusion</u>.... or <u>fear</u>.

And the longer one walks with God, the more one is apt to be *buffeted by Satan* with such <u>hellish weapons</u>.

Don't despair if you are going through such <u>an experience at this present time</u>.

God is trying to teach us *some powerful lessons* about feelings and *how to deal with them*.

Lesson One: My negative, blue, depressing feelings - did not come from God - so I don't have to put up with them!"

<u>2 Timothy 1:7</u> - NKJV

⁷ For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

I can <u>reject</u> every negative feeling because <u>I know</u> none of them are from God.

Feelings that make one afraid <u>are not sent from heaven</u> - they are *messengers* from the pits of hell!

They are to be <u>rejected</u> and <u>bound</u> through the power of <u>prayer and faith</u>.

Think of it - God is saying to us - "I didn't give you - feelings of fear and doubt.

- I've given you <u>a spirit of love</u>, <u>power</u>, and <u>authority</u>.
- We dare not *allow our feelings* to master us.
- Or permit them to <u>linger and grow</u> into *roots of <u>bitterness and doubt</u>*.

We must <u>come against them</u> in the name of Jesus - and <u>cast them down</u>!
We are <u>commanded</u> to do so!!!!!!!!!!!

2 Corinthians 10:5 - NKJV

⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

- *Every downcast feeling* is <u>the fruit of a satanic seed</u> of *mistrust*.
- <u>The old serpent at work again</u>, trying to make us <u>question</u> God's faithfulness.

It is <u>Satan</u> planting, in <u>our minds</u>, evil thoughts of <u>being abandoned</u> or <u>neglected</u> by God.

The devil wants God's children to think of themselves as spiritual orphans, left to their own ways and wit.

It is subtle and very dangerous- *because it is <u>rooted in a lie</u>*.

- The lie is this –
- God is with you to a point then you are on your own.
- He answers some prayers, but not all prayers.
- He delivers you from some temptations, but not all.
- He reveals Himself only to go back into hiding.

<u>Lies</u> - all lies and <u>the very seeds</u> of <u>our negative feelings</u>.

No wonder **God commands us** to <u>war against</u> them!!!!!!!!

Lesson Two: God can cause these messengers of Satan - these negative feelings - to praise Him!

<u>Psalm 76:10</u> - NKJV

¹⁰ Surely the wrath of man shall praise You; With the remainder of wrath You shall gird Yourself.

Living Bible - "Man's futile wrath will bring you glory. *You will use it as an ornament!*"

Negative feelings turned <u>into praise</u> are <u>an ornament</u> for our Lord and Savior!

God can show us all the sinfulness and evil still lurking in our hearts – by permitting Satan to buffet our minds with these messengers.

<u>Negative</u> thoughts <u>do not</u> originate <u>from God</u> -but they can be <u>permitted by God</u>.

When you sense <u>the enemy of your soul</u> pumping <u>negative feelings</u> into <u>your</u> <u>mind</u>, let it do its work <u>before casting them out</u>.

- Let those feelings <u>reveal to you how weak you are</u> <u>how dependent on</u> the grace, love and mercy of the Lord.
- Let those <u>sad</u>, confusing feelings show you <u>how evil the heart is</u> and how much <u>His strength</u> is needed, every day, every hour.
- Let it expose in you every remaining shred of pride, self-ego, ambition, secret sin, lust –
- And <u>bring you so low</u> you will never again boast about <u>how spiritual</u> or <u>mature you are</u>.

One depressing day of <u>negative feelings</u> can <u>knock out</u> of any Christian <u>every false</u> <u>notion of</u> *self-righteousness*.

God allows <u>disgrace</u> to make a way for <u>His grace</u>.

When your feelings cause you to suffer and grieve

 You can be sure <u>the Lord is trying to teach you</u> obedience and <u>complete</u> <u>trust in Himself</u>.

I have learned to **rest in Him** when swamped by *negative unwanted feelings*.

Hebrews 5:8 - NKJV

⁸ though He was a Son, yet <u>He learned obedience</u> by the things which He suffered.

Lesson Three: We must take comfort in knowing that our Lord feels what we feel, and He understands completely.

I take great comfort in <u>knowing</u> that my Savior understands my feelings. <u>He relates</u> to all I am experiencing.

Hebrews 4:15-16 - NKJV

¹⁵ For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are, yet* without sin.

¹⁶ Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Every feeling, He truly understands.

He never condemns me for suffering such attacks from the enemy.

- Instead, He tells me to hold on, and <u>be not afraid</u>.
- He lets me know **He too is familiar** with <u>this kind of struggle</u>.

Whether my negative feelings have been a result of <u>a physical</u> or <u>spiritual battle</u>, our Lord offers <u>comfort and help</u> when most needed.

What does our Lord mean by this?

He is encouraging all His dear children to quit fretting <u>when under the influence</u> of *negative thoughts*.

No more accusing yourself of failure and wickedness.

- Sin can be the cause of despair and fear but not always.
- So <u>don't</u> just lie down and take it!

Claim mercy, forgiveness, and grace to expel all negative feelings.

• That is **<u>Christ's formula</u>**, not mine.

• Having <u>claimed victory</u>, *ride out your storm in <u>a state of rest</u>*! Let God <u>dissipate the negative feelings</u> at <u>His own pace</u>.

Hebrews 6:15 - NKJV

¹⁵ And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

You can lie down to <u>sleep with this prayer</u> on your lips: Lord, I reject these <u>negative feelings</u> I commit them all to you. Give me a new assurance, take away all fear. Amen!"
