What We Worship

John 4 - Tell the story.

Jesus goes out of His way to speak to a woman who was a <u>5-time divorcée</u> and who is <u>living with a man</u> who she is not married to.

6th **hour of the day** – (<u>Hottest point of the day</u> to **avoid the ridicule** of the other women who would <u>go to the well in the morning</u>)

- Disappointments
- Regrets
- Past failures
- Relationship problems
- Why was she divorced 5 times?
- Shame
- Embarrassment

John 4:22 NKJV - You worship what you do not know; we know <u>what we worship</u>, for salvation is of the Jews.

- "You worship what you do not know"

There was evidently some **confusion** in her life.

- We would look at the situation and say; she *doesn't know* what she wants.
- She *can't* hold onto a husband.
- She *must have* this problem or that problem.
- But Jesus looks at this woman and after revealing to her that *he knows the failures* of her life says...
- "You are *confused* as to what you worship."

He <u>didn't</u> blame it on the alcohol

- *He didn't* blame it on <u>her parents</u> or <u>how she was raised</u>.
- *He didn't* blame it on <u>the addictions</u>.
- *He didn't* blame it on <u>her looks</u>.
- *He didn't* blame it on her <u>mental or emotional condition</u>.

He said, "You've been worshiping the wrong thing."

And in that moment *she becomes not only <u>a worshipper</u>* of Jesus Christ, but also <u>*an evangelist*</u> to the entire city of Samaria.

- Because of <u>her witness</u>, **Samaria was evangelized** with the gospel.
- **Great healings** happened later in Samaria.
- **The outpouring** of the Holy Ghost happened in Samaria.
- People were *healed and demons were cast out* of people...
- All because of this woman's change *in what she worshipped*.

Understand something – everyone worships <u>something</u>.

• Money – Fame – Hollywood - The Sports World – Themselves...

Jesus was speaking to a woman who had so much going in the wrong direction in her life.

- **5 times** she was joined in marriage to someone and **5 times** she was divorced.
- Her hope for a good marriage <u>was lost</u> because now she was simply living with a man.

Jesus goes out of His way to meet with her at the well of Samaria.

• Why this woman? Why this moment of her life?

Jesus wanted her to understand worship.

"You worship <u>what you do not know</u>"

- You are *confused* in your worship.
- You are *confused* as to what you worship.

I would like to suggest that <u>this world that we live in is</u> confused as to the object of their worship.

- <u>Sport</u> stars
- <u>Movie</u>stars
- Hollywood's Heroes Spiderman, Superman, Batman, Ninja Turtles 😊
- <u>Celebrities</u> of all kinds

It amazes me sometimes what appears to be the object of *people's worship*.

- Sadly, many people know that the object of their worship is not where it is supposed to be...
- Yet they are somehow **unwilling to change** the object of their worship.
- They are <u>addicted</u> to drugs.
- Their marriage is falling apart.
- Their kids are bent on self-destruction
- They can't keep a job.
- They can't keep a spouse.
- Their **addictions** are <u>killing them</u>.
- Their **past** is <u>haunting them</u>.
- Their *situations* of their life are <u>destroying them</u>
- They've <u>spent a lifetime worshipping the wrong thing</u> and no one can convince them <u>to give Jesus a try</u>, not even for a moment.

Jesus told this woman:

²³ But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

²⁴ God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

So there is *confusion* in the world that we live in *about what we worship*.

- Just as there was *confusion* in the day that <u>Jesus was speaking to this</u> <u>woman</u>, there is <u>confusion</u> today.
- People scream and shout to the top of their lungs at a ball game
- But when Jesus is in the house, they're timid and ashamed <u>to worship</u>.
- They jump up and down when their favorite team makes a scores -
- But when the <u>God of wonders</u> shows up, they <u>don't</u> even want to stand to honor Him.

People are <u>confused</u> about <u>what they worship</u>!!!!!

- **They complain** when the service <u>goes too long</u>, but then go home and spend hour after hour watching their <u>favorite programs on TV</u>.

People are confused about <u>what they worship</u>!!!!!

According to some estimates, there are roughly 4,200 religions in the world.

- 1.Christianity: 2.1 billion
- 2.Islam: 1.5 billion
- 3.Secular/Nonreligious/Agnostic/Atheist: 1.1 billion
- 4. Hinduism: 900 million
- 5. Chinese traditional religion: 394 million
- 6.Buddhism: 376 million

This world is confused about what it worships !!!!!

Jesus told the woman at the well,

²³ But the hour is coming, and now is, when <u>the true worshipers</u> will worship the **Father in spirit and truth**; for <u>the Father is seeking</u> such **to worship Him.**

²⁴ God *is* Spirit, and *those who worship Him* must worship in spirit and truth."

I believe what He was telling here was,

"You <u>don't</u> have to be <u>confused</u> about <u>what you worship</u> any longer!"

²⁵ The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

²⁶ Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

- Why did Jesus go out of His way to find this particular Samaritan woman?
- Why did he *reach out to this person* who *had so much confusion* in her life?

Can you imagine how *confusing* her home was?

• I wonder if she had kids with all 5 of her husbands?

I believe *Jesus reached out* to <u>the most confused person</u> He could find in Samaria for a reason!

I believe <u>Jesus likes bringing clarity</u> to <u>confusion</u>.

- If He could bring clarity and healing to her life -
- What more *could he do* in the rest of Samaria?

Listen to His words – 26 "I who speak to you am *He.*"

Jesus wanted her to know that if she was looking for someone to worship.

- If she was **in need of** a <u>celebrity</u>.
- If she was **in need of** a <u>hero</u>.
- If her life was craving something to *hang on to*...
- <u>He</u> was all she needed!!!!!!!!!

Standing right there in front of her was the -

- <u>King</u> of Kings.
- He was the <u>Lord</u> of Lords.
- <u>Alpha</u> <u>Omega</u>
- <u>The Creator</u> of the Universe
- <u>The One and Only</u> One who would <u>die for her</u> sins.
- Her <u>redeemer</u>
- Her savior
- The One who would love her when no one would love her
- The One who would love her in spite of her mistakes and failures!
- <u>Her</u> God!

I don't know what you have need of today, but *the One who <u>holds the Universe</u> together* is wanting to *help you* bring some *order to the confusion* in your life.

- And it all starts with **your worship**.
- It all starts with getting this *one priority* in its right perspective.

What are you worshipping today?

Listen to the woman...

25 - The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

She had the right idea...

- She was pointing in the <u>right direction</u>...
- She was waiting on the <u>right thing</u>...
- But she was **missing the moment** of **Worship**!
- She was missing her "When".
- She failed to recognize God when He showed up!

So many people *talk about God*, but very few of them *really worship Him*.

- They <u>talk</u> religion
- They <u>act</u> religious
- They <u>put on</u> a good game...

"We know that Christ will come and tell us all things..." It's always some futuristic thing for some people.

- Someday Christ will come.
- Someday, <u>I will go to church</u>.
- Someday, <u>I'll give up the junk in my life</u> and <u>start living for Jesus</u>.
- <u>Someday</u>... Yada Yada Yada, blah blah blah blah...

And *Jesus* told the woman, "HEY, I'M RIGHT HERE!"

- The one that you have been seeking is *right here in front of you*.
- The one that you have been waiting for to bring some direction...
- Order and stability into your life
- He went out of His way today to meet with you in this place.

I don't know if you've noticed it or not, but *there is a <u>presence of God</u> in this place today*.

- *His anointing* is in the house.
- There is *a sweet touch* on this service.

What have you been *worshipping*?

- How come there is such chaos?
- Why is it that *relationship after relationship fails* as miserably as the one before it?
- Some people can't even speak to their neighbors or their co-workers.

You may not believe this, but it matters what you are worshipping!

- It matters **whose praises** you are singing.
- It matters **whom you clap** your hands to.
- It matters **whom you raise** your hands in surrender to.
- It matters **who the object** of your affection is.
- It matters what or who you worship!!!

Are you worshipping *the creation*?

• Or are you *worshipping <u>the Creator</u>* today.

Are you worshipping the thing that is trying to destroy your life?

- Or are you worshipping the One who gave you your life?
- Where does all your time go?
- Where does all your attention go?
- Where does all <u>your money</u> go?
- What are you watching?
- What are you listening to?
- What gets you <u>pumped</u>?
- What gets you <u>excited</u>?
- Whose praises are you singing?
- What or who are you worshipping?

Understand something,

- There's *a God who loves you* this morning.
- There's *a savior who suffered and died* so you could have salvation today.
- There's <u>someone named Jesus</u> who <u>cares about you</u> and <u>yearns to be the</u> <u>object</u> of <u>your affection</u> here today.

CLOSE:

Jesus is here to bring *order to the confusion* in your life.

- He is here *to set you free* from the things that *have you bound* today.
- He wants to <u>heal you</u>.
- He wants to <u>bless your life</u>.
- He's *waiting on you* to *worship Him*.
- He's *waiting on you* to *yield yourself* to *no one else but Him*.

I wonder if you would.... WILL YOU?????
