Tested & Tempted – Part #3

Part #1 = <u>Depending On A Dependable God</u> (Matthew 4:1-4)

- In the time of <u>His weakened state the enemy comes</u> and says, <u>IF</u>...this is a word of <u>doubt</u>!
- Look at the words, <u>"It is written..."</u> Jesus takes the <u>seed of doubt</u> the tempter is trying to plant in His mind and battles it with an <u>absolute fact!</u>

Part #2 - <u>God Is Able To Protect</u> (Matthew 4:5-7)

THE DEVIL BEGINS TO QUOTE SCRIPTURE TO JESUS...

- The devil is taking these scriptures and using them to try and get Jesus to commit sin!
- This is not the first time the devil has taken the Word of God and tried to use it against people.

So when Jesus says, "Do not put the LORD your God to the test,"

- He is telling the devil, "<u>I will trust in God</u>.
- He is able to protect me.
- He will not fail me HE IS ABLE TO PROTECT ME!!!"

Do not allow the devil to tell you that because suffering exists in the world that

God is gone or distant! God is able to protect us!!!!!!

*** Today is the 3rd part of a 3 part series called, "Tested & Tempted."

We have looked at *what these temptations were* and *how Jesus overcame them.*

Today we will look at the final temptation brought by Satan in Matthew 4:8-11

Matthew 4:8-11 (NIV) - Submitting To God's Will

⁸Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor.

⁹ "All this I will give you," he said, "*if* you will bow down and worship me."

¹⁰ Jesus said to him, "<u>Away from me</u>, Satan! For it is written: '<u>Worship the Lord</u> your God, and serve him only.'

¹¹ *Then the devil left him*, and angels came and attended him.

In my office a few weeks ago <u>I begin to pray</u> as my mind was filled with <u>all kinds</u> <u>of issues</u> pertaining to the church, I just needed to pray through them!!!!

As I prayed the Lord spoke to me very plainly about things that need correcting.

I won't go into detail but I will share with you what **the Lord talked to me about -**<u>me</u>.

Basically the Lord impressed in my heart this question: "Are you tired of doing it yourself, yet?"

OUR nature is to do – to do everything – to try and control everything.

I have had to repent of this and the Lord is beginning to work by helping me to see the great ministry many of you possess.

In reality what I have done is tried to lead in such a way that <u>God had no room to</u> <u>operate</u>.

In other words I have *fallen for the temptation* to rule my own life and the life of this church **instead of allowing God to rule!!!!**

But I know I am not alone in my actions this morning......

All of us have an area in life where we try to lead instead of allowing God to lead.

What is that area for you????

- Is God the Lord of your career?
- Is God the Lord of your education?
- Is God the Lord of your finances?
- Is God the Lord of your possessions?
- Is God the Lord of your home?
- Is God the Lord of the way you raise your children?
- Is God the Lord of your marriage?
- You may be asking, "What do you mean, Lord?"

Lord is not just another title for Jesus but <u>it means someone</u> who has authority, <u>power</u> or <u>influence</u>.

Does Jesus have authority, power of influence in your decisions, your career, your finances?

"Is there any part of your life where you have put up a **DO NOT TRESPASS** sign?"

- What part of your life have you allowed the devil to tell you that God has no business being a part of?
- What part of your life *have you told God*, "<u>I will control this part</u>, Jesus, and when I need you I'll give you a call!"

There is one thing we have to get straight this morning.

We **CANNOT** make Jesus the Lord of anything. *HE IS ALREADY THE LORD OF LORDS!*

• What you and I have to do is *"submit"* our will to His Lordship.

When we read Matthew 4:8-11 *what we are seeing is*.....

- The devil trying to tempt Jesus (the human) to <u>take charge</u> and <u>take</u>
 <u>control</u> of this situation
- Instead of letting <u>God be in control</u>.
- He offers Jesus the whole world *if......*
- He will just *push God out* of the picture.

Matthew 4:8 - ⁸ **Again**, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor.

Whenever I read this verse I kind of laugh to myself!!!!!

• The very first word strikes me in a humorous way, "again."

Remember Jesus has been in the desert going on 40 days and during this whole time *the devil is working Him over with temptations*.

- I don't believe **the devil** <u>came and tempted Jesus then went away</u> until the next temptation.
- **No!** He was there talking, *pushing and tempting* for the entire 40 days.

He had already lost two opportunities to get Jesus to fall and now Matthew says, *again*!

Last week we saw how the devil took Jesus to the top of the Temple and from there Jesus could see the city of Jerusalem.

In this temptation the devil takes Jesus to the top of the mountain and shows Him, <u>"the world and its splendor."</u> Then he says,

Matthew 4:9 - ⁹ "All this I will give you," he said, "*if* you will bow down and worship me."

What is the devil trying to give to Jesus?

- It is, "the world and its splendor."
- Try to *picture the scene* in your mind.
- They are on the *top of the mountain* and somehow, someway
- The devil shows Jesus not just the kingdom of Israel
- But also of *the whole world*;
- And he shows Jesus *all the great glory and splendor*.

"There is one **<u>question</u>** that we have to ask ourselves when reading this verse:

Does the world and its splendor belong to devil or to God?"

Is all of this the devils to give away?

This is **not a simple question** to answer!!!

On one hand we could say, <u>no.</u> Jesus is the Creator of all things, <u>which makes Him</u> <u>the owner</u> of all things – <u>including the world</u>.

However, the Bible informs us that <u>for a time the devil</u> has been given some control...

John 12:31, 14:30 & 16:11 calls the devil the "prince" or "ruler" of "this world."

Paul writes in <u>2 Corinthians 4:4</u> – The <u>god of this age</u> [world] blinded the minds of unbelievers, <u>so that they cannot see the light</u> of the gospel of the glory of Christ..."

• The devil is called the god of the world or age (time).

So does the devil <u>have the authority</u> to give away the kingdoms of this world and its splendor?

The devil has <u>*no power or authority*</u> other than what is given to him either by God or by us!

- When we fail to **allow Jesus to be the Lord** then our lord is the devil.
- On the other hand, *if we surrender all aspects of our life to Jesus*
- He becomes Lord!!!
- <u>The devil loses control</u> and <u>has nothing</u> to offer us!

Jesus <u>demonstrates His authority over Satan</u> (v. 10).

Matthew 4:10 - ¹⁰ Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'

Jesus in His humanity was tempted to push God to the side and do His own thing.

- He was tempted to try and <u>take over</u> <u>take control</u> <u>take authority</u>
- But He did not give way to *this temptation*.
- He made a choice <u>to submit His flesh</u> to *the will of God* and <u>not</u> to the will of Satan.

Jesus chose to remember that <u>He was sent into this world</u> to SAVE IT – NOT TAKE IT OVER!

- He chose <u>God's plan</u> and not His own.
- He chose to worship God by obeying the plan of God!

Satan can only offer you and I <u>what we are willing to take</u> or <u>whatever we are</u> <u>willing to surrender too</u>.

The Apostle Paul explained this to the church at Rome...

<u>**Romans 6:16</u>** - Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey—whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?</u>

The devil has power over us when we bow down and worship him!!!

- I know what some of you are thinking, "I don't worship the devil!
- I am not a Satan worshiper!"
- When we were *born again we were set free*!
- Part of that freedom is to *continue to choose <u>who we will serve</u>:*
- God or the devil!!!!!!!

When we obey sin – <u>we worship the devil</u> – we live in <u>bondage!</u> When we obey righteousness - <u>we worship God</u> – we live in <u>freedom!</u>

This thing called **"living for God"** is a merely getting up every day and choosing whom we will serve.

If you serve Satan then he will be able to offer you the world

• *We will* <u>fall for the temptation</u> and <u>live in bondage</u>.

If we choose to serve God then Satan has no power

• And *cannot fool us* with the <u>lustful things of this world</u>.

We have to **make a decision** as a body of believers:

- We will **choose God's plan** over man's plan.
- We will **choose to do the right things** no matter what the cost.

Satan will offer this church and its members all kinds of reasons to give up on God's leading and take charge of everything themselves.

We have **hundreds of churches** in this city that are **no longer led by the Spirit** but have given into the latest trends and doctrines.

We **will** <u>not</u> become one of those churches.

- We *will <u>not</u> become* a Sunday social gathering place.
- <u>We will stand against the temptation to let our flesh rule</u>
- <u>We will prevail over Satan</u> because JESUS IS THE LORD OF THIS CHURCH!

Will you help this church to resist the temptation?

- How can I do that?
- How can I help?"
- Well it's this simple:
- MAKE HIM THE LORD OF YOUR LIFE!

Close:

Someone may say, "Pastor, how do I do that?"

• I'm glad you asked 🕲

I want you to imagine that <u>your heart is your home</u>. <u>If</u> Jesus is to be Lord of your life then you have to <u>let him into</u> your home (heart).

You do this one room at a time.

<u>1.</u> <u>Let Him</u> Into Your library – in other words let Jesus take a look at the books, magazines, videos, television shows and computer websites you look at. Ask yourself this question, "Can Jesus watch this with me?"

Or would I be embarrassed if Jesus looked at what I look at or listen too.

<u>2.</u> <u>Let Him</u> Into Your Dining Room – what are those things you desire more than Jesus? What are the things you want to eat more than the bread of life?

Job, career, education – these things are important but they are not what keeps you alive.

<u>3.</u> <u>Let Him</u> Into Your Family Lounge – how are your relationships with your family members. *Are there some things you need to ask forgiveness for?*

Are there things you need to forgive? Jesus sees us when we fight and complain! *Would Jesus be comfortable* sitting in your lounge or would He be concerned about your family relationships.

<u>4.</u> <u>Let Him</u> Into Your Workshop – does Jesus have any say at all in your working decisions? Do people at your workplace or school know that you are a Christian?

Have you allowed Jesus to be a vital part of how you do your work for His glory?

<u>5.</u> <u>Let Him</u> Into Your Office – all of us have a place in our home where we take care of financial matters. We balance our accounts, go over bills, talk about finances.

Let me ask you, "Does Jesus have influence over your checking account, your savings account, or the money you have tucked away in a jar?"

Do you spend more on things to satisfy your personal wants and desires but are unwilling to submit your finances to the leadership of Christ?
