# **Laying The Axe To The Root**

## Matthew 3:1-12 NIV - John the Baptist Prepares the Way

**3** In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea<sup>2</sup> and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." <sup>3</sup> This is he who was spoken of through *the prophet Isaiah: (Isaiah 40:3)* 

# "A voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'"

<sup>4</sup>John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. <sup>5</sup> People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan. <sup>6</sup> Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.

<sup>7</sup> But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to where he was baptizing, he said to them: "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? <sup>8</sup> Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. <sup>9</sup> And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as <u>our</u> father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham. <sup>10</sup> The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.

<sup>11</sup> "I baptize you with (Or In) water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you <u>with</u> (Or In) the Holy Spirit and fire. <sup>12</sup> His winnowing fork <u>is</u> in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire."

- They wasn't aware that they were standing in The Doorway of Prophecy!
- The Root and <u>offspring of David</u> was near... <u>the Messiah</u>!
- God always sends <u>a preacher to stir</u> the pot: and announce what's happening!

# There are 3 kinds of people:

- Those that *Make things happen*
- Those that **Watch things** happen
- Those that **Wonder what happened**......

## NOW THERE IS NO DOUBT **JOHN WAS ONE THAT MADE THINGS HAPPEN!**

HIS MESSAGE WAS SIMPLE: Repent, the Kingdom is at hand! --(the church)

**Repent**, Because **God is ready** to do a new thing!

#### **WE SHOULD BE HONORED TO BE PREACHED TO:**

God is sharing his plan and wants us to participate!!!

**John 15:15** - <sup>15</sup> I no longer call you servants, because <u>a servant does not know</u> his master's business. Instead, <u>I have called you friends</u>, for everything that I learned from my Father <u>I have made known to you.</u>

I Corinthians 1:21 - <sup>21</sup> For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased <u>through the foolishness of what was preached</u> to save those who believe.

#### FOOLISHNESS OF PREACHING ---- NOT FOOLISH PREACHING

The absurdity, the simplicity of it...

# <u>Many Jews</u> considered the **GOOD NEWS** of Jesus Christ <u>to be foolish</u>...

- They thought <u>the Messiah</u> would be <u>a conquering king w/signs & miracles</u>...
- Jesus had not restored David's throne <u>as they expected</u>...
- Besides, <u>He was executed</u> as a criminal...<u>HOW could a criminal be a Savior</u>...

# <u>Greeks</u>, too, considered <u>the gospel foolish</u>:

- They did not believe in a bodily resurrection
- They thought **no reputable** person would be crucified
- To them, death was defeat, not victory...

# The Good News of Jesus still sounds foolish to many...

- *Our society worships* power, influence, and wealth....
- Jesus came as a <u>humble</u>, <u>poor</u> servant...
- HE offers His kingdom to those who HAVE FAITH....

It's absurd to take an imperfect human to preach a perfect Gospel to an imperfect world!

## **NEVERTHELESS - Christ Crucified Is God's Power and Wisdom**

<u>1 Corinthians 1:18</u> - For <u>the message of the cross</u> is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved <u>it is the power of God.</u>

Like John's day... so it is with ours: "WE TRY TO DISCREDIT PREACHING"

**Matthew 3:4** - John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey.

## WE PAINT HIM AS SOME WILD EYED, UNEDUCATED, HICK, JACK LEG LUNATIC!

- Camel's Hair (type of clothing)
- Leather Mantle
- Locust = (some say a tree) Nevertheless, people ate locust (protein)

\*SYMBOLIC: Locust was type of judgment & Honey was a type of Canaan

## JUDGMENT IS OVER... GRACE IS ON ITS WAY!

\*POINT: John was not some wild eyed nut!

 He was <u>an articulate prophet of God</u> filled with <u>the Holy Ghost</u> from his mother's womb who shook his world and prepared it for Jesus Christ!

MULTITUDES WERE <u>MOVED AT HIS PREACHING</u>... AND <u>WERE BAPTIZED</u>! *(still works)* 

# He challenged the Religious Order:

**Matt. 3:8-9** – Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. <sup>9</sup> And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as <u>our</u> father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham.

# John the Baptist called people to more than words or ritual.

He told them to change their behavior –

- produce fruit in keeping with repentance...
- Do your actions match your word?????

**Matt. 3:10** - <sup>10</sup> *The ax is already at the root* of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.

• Each tree <u>has to have fruit</u> - Let's see some <u>repentance</u>

\*JOHN'S MESSAGE: The axe must be laid to the root! REPENTANCE!

\*\*\*\* The ROOT is where things spring from \*\*\*\*

**Luke 6:45** - A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For the mouth speaks **what the heart is full of**. ----

## Our Root is our Heart!

**Romans 11:16** - If the part of the dough offered as first fruits <u>is</u> holy, then the whole batch <u>is</u> holy; if <u>the root is</u> holy, so <u>are</u> the branches.

\*POINT: REPENTANCE IS NOT PRUNING! (Clipping outer edges for looks)

#### REPENTANCE IS LAYING AN AXE TO THE ROOT OF THE ROOT!

- Some folks are only **spiritually mowing the lawn** ---
- Never getting to the bottom line of the problem! ---
- REPENTANCE IS = "<u>WEED BE GONE</u>!"
- GET RID OF YOUR SINFUL ACTIONS "cut it out" "stop it"

James 1:12-15 - <sup>12</sup> Blessed <u>is</u> the one who perseveres under <u>trial</u> because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

<sup>13</sup> When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; <sup>14</sup> but each person *is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed*. <sup>15</sup> Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

#### **OUR SIN PROBLEM** CAN BE WASHED AWAY IN ONE SERVICE!

Our fascination with sin isn't...

WE ARE DRAWN BY OUR OWN LUST (strong desire) -- when acted upon is sin!

\*<u>OURPROBLEM</u>: <u>we use our past</u> to justify our desires!

We constantly wish to analyze our parents etc... to explain our desires

#### **BUT THE BIBLE DOES NOT DEAL WITH US SO:**

- <u>Pronounces us Sinners</u> and says Get on with it!
- LOOK FORWARD & UPWARD!

**FAITH chapter - Hebrews 11:10** – (Abraham) -For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder *is* God.

11:13-16 - All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw <u>them</u> and welcomed <u>them</u> from a distance, admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth. <sup>14</sup> People who say such things show that they are looking for a <u>country</u> of their own. <sup>15</sup> If they had been thinking of the <u>country</u> they had left, they would have had opportunity to return. <sup>16</sup> <u>Instead</u>, they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them.

**Hebrews 11:20-22 - By faith Isaac <u>blessed</u>** Jacob and Esau <u>in regard to their</u> <u>future</u>.

#### **ALL LOOKED AHEAD!**

**Hebrews 11:25 – (Moses) He chose** to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. **HOW COULD HE DO IT?** 

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>21</sup> By faith Jacob, when he was dying, <u>blessed</u> each of Joseph's sons, and worshiped as he *leaned* on the top of his staff.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>22</sup> By faith Joseph, when his end was near, spoke about the exodus of the Israelites from Egypt and gave instructions concerning the burial of his bones.

**11:26** – He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because *he was looking ahead* to his reward.

**11:37-40** – (Many other prophets) They were put to death by stoning; they were sawed in two; they were killed by the sword. They went about in sheepskins and goatskins, destitute, persecuted and mistreated— <sup>38</sup> the world was not worthy of them. They wandered <u>in</u> deserts and mountains, living <u>in</u> caves and in holes <u>in</u> the ground.

<sup>39</sup> These were <u>all commended</u> for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised, <sup>40</sup> since <u>God had planned something better</u> for us so that only together with us would they be made perfect.

#### **NOW LISTEN UP CLOSE...**

**Hebrews 12:2** - <sup>2</sup> <u>fixing our eyes on Jesus</u>, the pioneer and perfecter <u>of</u> faith. For <u>the joy set before him</u> he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

**12:1** - Therefore, <u>since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses</u>, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let <u>us</u> run with perseverance the race marked out for <u>us</u>,

STOP LOOKING IN THE REAR VIEW MIRROR AND GET ON WITH LIFE!

#### LAY ASIDE EVERY WEIGHT & SIN:

Wanna know why you can't stop DRINKING, SMOKING, CUSSING, ADULTERY,

UNTIL <u>OUR LOVE FOR HIM</u> <u>**OVER POWERS OUR LOVE FOR SIN**</u> - <u>NOTHING WILL</u> CHANGE!

## \*CLOSE:

The <u>axe must get laid to the root!</u>

HERE THE INSTRUCTION!

\*\*\*\* Philippians 3:13 - Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. *But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind* and straining toward what is ahead,

## "THIS ONE THING I DO"

John said that if we would prepare ourselves with "axe to root" repentance

# HE WOULD BAPTIZE US WITH THE (Acts 2:4) HOLY GHOST!

• That is a promise!
