UNCOVER YOUR ROOF

Opening: **<u>High expectations</u> - - -

I want you to come into this message with high expectations.

- I want you to put your mind in a state of anticipation
- I fully believe that <u>God is going to work</u> a *work in our midst today*
- I have come to cause you to "exercise your faith"

Exercise means to use - - -

- If we do not exercise then we become slow, fat, and lazy in the natural sense
- If we **do not exercise** in <u>the spiritual realm of faith</u>, then we can become **weak and ineffective** Christians.

Exercise your faith today - - -

- Stretch out of the <u>comfort zone</u> of your **current expectations**
- Move into the *operation of God's power* in your life
- Let all your worries and cares sweat away this morning
- We are **exercising** *our faith*

Mark 2:1-12- NKJV - Jesus Forgives and Heals a Paralytic

2 And again He entered Capernaum after *some* days, and it was heard that He was in the house.

² Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive *them*, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them.

³Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four *men*.

⁴ And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they <u>uncovered</u> <u>the roof</u> where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying.

⁵ When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, **your sins are forgiven you.**"

⁶ And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, ⁷ "Why does this *Man* speak blasphemies like this? *Who can forgive sins but God alone?*"

⁸ But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts?

⁹Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, '*Your* sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'?

¹⁰ But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the paralytic,

¹¹ "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."

¹² <u>Immediately</u> he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"

** Familiar story - - -

But there are some *truths to be gleaned* from this passage of scripture

There are some *important points* that need to be mentioned from this passage of scripture

- There is an example and template here - -
- That we can learn from and apply to our own lives and situation.

**Jesus was in the house - <u>Vs1</u> - And again He entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that <u>He was in the house</u>.

A. Jesus <u>entered into</u> the city of Capernaum

This was the hometown of Simon Peter

• It is more than likely that this was the house that Jesus went to.

B. Jesus goes to the house of the believer

Peter was <u>Jesus' disciple</u> - He <u>followed Jesus</u> everywhere!!!

So when they came to <u>Peter's house</u> Jesus went inside

- If you want <u>Jesus in your house</u> - -
- You've got to <u>be **a believer**</u> You've got to <u>follow Jesus</u>

Jesus *doesn't* just go to anybody's house

- I am sure there were <u>nicer homes</u> in the city of Capernaum
- There undoubtedly were <u>richer men</u> than Peter

But Jesus didn't go to any of their houses - <u>He went</u> to the house of his follower!

- It doesn't matter how much money you have
- It doesn't matter how <u>famous</u> you are
- It doesn't matter what **position** you hold in this life
- The <u>only thing</u> that matters is, <u>do you have Jesus</u> in your house?

Church, the most important thing is, do we have Jesus in the House?

• We're not the <u>biggest</u>, <u>best known</u>, <u>program filled</u> church!

That's <u>not</u> important – because <u>we've got Jesus</u> in the house!

C. It was noised <u>vs1</u> People heard that Jesus <u>was in the house</u>!!! ^{vs2} Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive *them*, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them.

• And so many came that the house **<u>could not</u>** contain them

We've got to let people know that Jesus is in the house

• We can't keep silent or still - We've got to witness and testify

What happens when people find out that Jesus is in the house?

• There were so many coming that <u>the house could not</u> contain them...

As long as we let people know that Jesus is here in "MY CHURCH" ---

- **Revival will follow -** So many that <u>we will not be able</u> to contain them all.

**The Paralyzed man - - - <u>vs</u> 3 & 4

³Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four *men*.

⁴And when **they could not** come near Him because of the crowd, they <u>uncovered</u> <u>the roof</u> where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying.

A. Notice the situation

<u>So many people</u> around the house that <u>nobody else could get close</u> to Jesus.

- These four guys have a friend that is a paralytic.
- Whether he was <u>born this way</u> or became this way <u>through sickness</u> or <u>accident</u> the Bible does not specify.

They know they need to get to Jesus...

- People <u>know what they need</u> - When you get desperate you find Jesus.
- <u>Churches</u> were full on <u>9/11</u>because <u>people were desperate</u>.

They <u>can't</u> get to Jesus <u>the ordinary way</u>, so they climb up on top of the house and <u>remove the roof</u>.

- The *obstacles* were before them But they **didn't** let that stop them
- The crowd <u>didn't part</u> to allow them to <u>come to Jesus</u>

So they *made their own way*!!! - - - They *took the roof off* of the house!!!

There had to be a part of their minds that was saying -

- This is crazy - This is expensive - this is not going to work......
- But they *took the roof off....*

***Take the Roof off - - -

A. A roof is a <u>metaphor for a limit</u>

In the business world, when <u>you have advanced as far as you are going to</u>, they say that <u>you have reached your ceiling</u>

In some cases with prejudice or sexism, they describe it as a "glass ceiling"

- This is your limit, you can't go beyond this
- No matter how hard you work or how qualified you may feel - -
- You have <u>reached your limit</u> <u>your ceiling</u>.

In 2011 we found out that the United States has a debt ceiling

- This is as *high as we will allow the debt to go*
- <u>Then</u> they changed it But <u>a ceiling was in place</u> to limit the national debt.

In the <u>aeronautics world</u>, the <u>ceiling</u> is the maximum altitude that <u>an airplane</u> <u>can travel.</u>

• After that altitude the plane's engines do not receive enough air to continue to function, and the plane can go into a stall and crash.

That's the ceiling – that's the roof!!!

<u>It's your limit</u> – where <u>you can't go beyond</u> this point.

B. Take the roof off

As I mentioned the men must have been <u>thinking some things as they climbed</u> up to the roof. This is crazy - This is expensive - This is hard and long - This is not going to work. These are all <u>roofs on our lives</u> today!

C. Faith says to <u>step out into the impossible</u>

Crazy is **stepping out of a perfectly good boat** in the middle of a storm.

• But *faith says* – <u>I can walk on water</u> with Jesus

Crazy is bringing five loaves and two fishes to feed five thousand people

- But *faith says* <u>Jesus will provide</u>
- The *apostle Paul* put it this way I have become a fool for Christ

Faith is in the realm of the crazy -

• <u>That's just a roof that</u> you need to <u>tear off</u> of your life

<u>Tear that roof off your life</u> by-<u>stepping into</u> what God has called you to.

D. Faith says no cost is too great

In the natural sense the *destruction of the roof* must have been quite costly.

- We're going to have to <u>pay Peter back</u> for tearing up his roof.
- But **no cost is too great** *to receive what we need from Jesus* by faith.

In our lives we face <u>costly decisions</u>.

It's time to tear that roof off of your life!

Tear the roof off your finances through faithfulness to God.

<u>I tore the roof off</u> my finances

- My family has **been** <u>faithful</u> in tithes and offerings.
- We are <u>faithful to God</u>, so <u>I can expect God</u> to be faithful to me as well.

I am <u>not the only one</u> that is stepping into the blessings of God this month

Those that are faithful are starting to receive *the benefits of their faithfulness*.

<u>Jobs</u> are being opened up – <u>provision</u> is being made – <u>miracles</u> are happening all around us –

Why because we have been faithful to God - - -

- **Corina** is a faithful saint
- Lorrenzo Loves God & is Faithful
- Fred Shultz Loves God and is Faithful
- **SANDY Shultz** Healed by Jesus' stripes faithful to God
- Jessica Miller Faithful servant of God

The Inheritance and bonus - *Faithful people that* took the roof off!!!

E. Faith says <u>I will see this through</u>

In the natural sense tearing a roof off is hard work...

• There was <u>effort</u> and <u>sweat involved</u> - Maybe there were <u>some cuts and</u> <u>splinters</u>

• To be sure, *the roof did not come off quickly*

In <u>the spiritual sense</u> tearing the roof off <u>of your faith</u> takes time

• It is in the daily walk with God - It is in your personal prayer life

It is in <u>enduring through</u> trials and hardships

<u>Tear off</u> the roof of sin today!

- The Bible describes <u>the Holy Ghost as rain</u>
- Some people don't feel the rain of the Holy Ghost - -
- Because they are <u>under a roof of sin</u>

They've put up <u>barriers of iniquity</u> between them and God!!!

So when <u>the presence of God</u> is moving in the service <u>they sit unaffected</u>, <u>because</u> the roof of sin is on their life

- <u>It's time</u> to **tear that roof off today**
- <u>It's time to get right with God</u>

F. Faith says I have <u>no doubt</u>

As the men were tearing off the roof, I am sure they were thinking – <u>what if</u> this doesn't work?

- **Doubt** tried to worm it's way into their minds
- But they kept tearing at that roof

Your mind is going to say – what if it doesn't work for me?

- What if <u>I step out in witnessing</u> and <u>nobody listens</u>?
- What if <u>I become faithful in tithing</u> and <u>end up worse than before</u>?
- What if <u>I reach for Jesus</u> this morning <u>and don't receive</u>.

The enemy will try to plant <u>doubt and fear</u> into your mind.

When you don't believe, you don't pull the roof off

Doubt leads to inaction - Faith spurs us into motion

Tear <u>the roof of doubt</u> off today

• I told you to **raise your expectations** this morning

Not What if I step out in witnessing? – <u>I'm going to go</u> and get a Bible Study

<u>Not What if</u> I become faithful in tithing? – <u>I will be faithful</u> and God will provide for me

Not What if I reach for Jesus today? – <u>I will receive</u> the Holy Ghost

Not What if <u>I come to the altar</u>? – <u>God will heal me</u>!!! Not What if <u>I pray for my lost family</u>? – <u>God's going to</u> save them all. Not, <u>I've fallen too far</u> for Jesus to reach me? – <u>His grace is enough</u> for me Not What if <u>I ask Jesus for his touch today</u>? –<u>I will receive</u> what I need today –

CLOSE: ***When the roof comes off

VS5 - When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you."

Vs. 5 When Jesus saw their faith -

He saw the hole in the roof - Sins were forgiven - Miracles took place...

- Come on saint of God <u>tear your roof off this morning</u>!
- Maybe <u>like the four men</u> in Capernaum - -
- You *are <u>tearing the roof off for someone else</u> this morning.*

Their faith affected their friend...

Maybe you can <u>take someone that is going through something</u> this morning by the hand and <u>like those men</u> bring them to Jesus.....

If you are ready to *tear the roof off of your faith* this morning - come to this altar right now!

Tear it off your <u>finances</u> - Tear it off your <u>sickness</u> - Tear it off your <u>situation</u> - Tear it off your <u>unsaved loved ones</u>...

Tear it off your witness and revival

Tear it off your heart and your salvation

When you tear the roof off - - -

<u>YOU receive</u> what you <u>need</u> from Jesus Christ!
