Let Me Show You Jesus

Matthew 5:16 – NKJV - ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 25:34-40 - NKJV

Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: ³⁵ for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; ³⁶ I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.'

³⁷ "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink? ³⁸ When did we see You a stranger and take *You* in, or naked and clothe *You*? ³⁹ Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?'

⁴⁰ And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me.'

We live in a world of words. (Yet, Let me show you Jesus).

- We communicate with our words.
- No matter where you go in this world today, you will find there a language that is spoken.
- It may be different than the language that is spoken where you come from, but there are <u>languages made up of words nonetheless</u>.

I have traveled to other places in the world to do mission work and it is always very <u>strange and uncomfortable</u> when I am in a place where I do not speak or understand the language.

- Many times I've had to gesture to someone what I want
- Or use facial expressions to acknowledge my appreciation for their help
- Or assistance because I didn't speak their language.

Language is important

• Without it <u>communication is lost</u>

But there are some things that <u>language cannot explain</u>.

- There are some things that words cannot express.
- There are some things that <u>you just have to see</u> with your own eyes.

I could try all day to describe to you the grandeur of the Grand Canyon

- But until you have stood on the cliff that overhangs the side of it -
- Then You have <u>never really experienced</u> the Grande Canyon.

I could talk all day and do my best to explain the suffering that goes on in much of the world today –

- But until you've seen it with your own eyes
- You would <u>never</u> understand how <u>many people in the world live today</u>.

Understand that there are some things in this world that are just -

- Too complex and too vast and too amazing to try to explain with words -
- You just have to go see some things for yourself.

If I really wanted you to understand -

- What it is that I am trying <u>to convey to you</u> or <u>show you</u> about something,
- *I would serve you better by* taking you to the thing or <u>showing it to you</u> first hand
- So you could understand fully what it was I am describing with my words.
- You just have to experience it for yourself.

I hear so many people today trying to tell the world who Jesus is

- I hear so many preachers even on TV doing their best to describe to this troubled world Who Jesus is.
- I'm standing here this morning <u>trying my best with words</u> to speak to you <u>about Him</u>......
- To share with you <u>a message I believe</u> He would want me to share with you.

When the message is over...

- When the **sermon is finished**...
- I then have to **show you Jesus**.

The sermon here today is only part of my job as Pastor, to show you who Jesus is.

- I have to then live Jesus in front of you.
- I then have to extend grace as Jesus would.
- I then have to <u>love you</u> the way Jesus loves you.
- I have to <u>forgive and restore you</u> the way He wants to <u>forgive and restore</u> <u>you</u>.

Through the years <u>I've been on the job</u> or <u>in the workplace</u> where **some well meaning Christian** is preaching to their co-workers.

- With cheap and <u>even idle words</u> they <u>try to win these people</u> without attempting to show the person Jesus.
- Without ever stepping out of their comfort zone, <u>they use words</u> to try <u>to</u> show people the Love of God.

We need to understand today that **words could never** <u>truly describe the Love of</u> *Jesus*.

• Words can never fully <u>depict the vast</u> and <u>incredible love</u> that our savior has for us today.

If this world <u>is ever going to see Jesus</u>, they are going to have to **see** it <u>not</u> by our words, <u>but by our actions</u>.

- Our shirts should say, "Let me show you Jesus".
- That's a bold statement.
- I would say that is *the boldest statement* we as a church could make.
- "Let me show you Jesus."

Showing people Jesus is going to take commitment.

- Showing people Jesus is going to take **sacrifice**.
- Showing people Jesus is going to take <u>us getting out of our comfort zones</u>.
- It's going to take us going into <u>some neighborhoods we may not feel</u> <u>comfortable going into</u>.
- It's going to take us **spending time with someone who makes us feel uneasy**.
- It's going to take us *feeding the hungry*

- Clothing the naked
- Visiting the <u>sick and imprisoned</u>.
- It's going to take us *acting like Christians* instead of heathens.
- It's going to take us <u>reaching out to help our neighbors</u>.
- It's going to take us <u>loving this world</u> that may very well <u>hate us</u>.

If we are going to show this world Jesus, it may very well take a whole lot more than what the world has been seeing in us.

I've seen and even been one of those who go door to door telling people about Jesus Christ.

- We stand on their doorsteps and ask them to join us at church.
- We tell them that our religion is better than what they have.
- We tell them that we have Jesus living in our hearts.

<u>The problem that many people have is</u> they have Jesus all locked up tight in their hearts and they never let Him out.

- **He's become** some little thing that they only do on a Sunday morning.
- **He's only** taken out <u>when they have some need</u> or <u>problem in their life</u>.

I want you to know today that if we could ever get Jesus out of here (Heart)

- If we could ever get to a point where people are seeing Jesus in and through us.
- If we could ever get to the place where they don't even need to hear our words to see our God Then we would truly be showing people Jesus.

We all know today that this world needs to see Jesus.

- We all know today that the only hope for this troubled world is that they
 might come into a relationship with the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords.
- He is the answer for the world's problems.
- He is the only one who can heal them.
- This world needs to see Jesus
- They don't need to see Sim they need to see Jesus.

I don't know about you, but *I've grown very tired of my own attempt to reach* people with words.

- Words are cheap.
- Words are <u>easy</u>.
- Words don't take much commitment.
- Words don't take much sacrifice.

Anybody can offer words,

- Who wants to feed someone who has no food.
- Who would go in their closet and help cloth those without.
- Who would care for and minister to someone who has fallen sick.
- Who would buy a Christmas gift for a child that they don't even know?

CLOSE:

"Let me show you Jesus" is the Theme of this church.

- It is our mantra.
- It is who we will become.
- We're not there yet, but we're heading in that direction very quickly.
- **MYCHURCH will be more than** just a place to have church; it will become <u>a</u> beacon and a lighthouse to the community in which God placed us.
- It will be a place where lives are truly changed.
- It will be a place where <u>hope is absolutely restored</u>.
- It will be a place where <u>people can see Jesus</u> through those who call themselves MY CHURCH.

We say we have a great message.

- We say we have a great hope.
- We say we have something that the world needs.
- Let's stop saying it and <u>let's start showing it</u>.
- Let's begin to minister to those who God places before us.
- Let's start to become what we keep preaching about.

Let's show them Jesus.

Mark 16:15-18 – NKJV - ¹⁵ And He said to them, "<u>Go</u> into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶ He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

¹⁷ And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

If you truly want to make a difference in someone's life,

- Why don't you take an hour or two out of your busy schedule *and teach* them what the bible says.
- **Show them** that you care enough about them that you would sacrifice your time to teach them a bible study.

There seems to be an emphasis on the word Go in vs. 15,

- In fact it's capitalized for a reason.
- Many people want to <u>preach the gospel</u> as long as <u>they don't have to go</u> anywhere.
- Now I'm not saying <u>you have to move</u> to some other nation to share Word
 of God with people, but <u>you do have to go</u>.
- You have to go into their homes.
- You have to go into their school.
- You have to go <u>into wherever</u> it is that **they live** in order to <u>share this</u> <u>message</u> with them.
- You can't show someone Jesus if you're not willing to get in your car and drive to his or her house once in a while to minster to him or her.
- That's what it's going to take for you to show them Jesus isn't it...?

Let me show you Jesus. - Let me introduce you to Him.

Let me demonstrate for you who He really is and how much He cares for you.
