### Five Ways the Devil Can Bind Our Worship

**Psalm 99:1-4** – CEV - **Our LORD Is King** - <sup>1</sup><u>**Our LORD, you are King!**</u> You rule from your throne above the winged creatures, as people tremble and the earth shakes. <sup>2</sup>**You are praised** in Zion, and <u>you control all</u> nations. <sup>3</sup>**Only you are God!** And your power alone, so great and fearsome, <u>is worthy of praise</u>. <sup>4</sup>You are <u>our</u> <u>mighty King</u>, a lover of fairness, who sees that justice is done everywhere in Israel.

<sup>5</sup><u>Our Lord and our God</u>, **we praise you** and kneel down *to worship you*, the God of holiness! <sup>6</sup>Moses and Aaron were two of your priests. Samuel was also one of those who prayed in your name, and you, our Lord, answered their prayers. <sup>7</sup>You spoke to them from a thick cloud, and they obeyed your laws. <sup>8</sup>Our Lord and our God, you answered their prayers and forgave their sins, but when they did wrong, you punished them. <sup>9</sup>We praise you, Lord God, and we worship you at your sacred mountain. Only you are God!

# Worship is important to the church. As a matter of fact, the church is powerless without worship.

- Worship is *important to the soul*.
- Worship is how we go into <u>the presence of God</u>.
- If we <u>don't</u> worship, <u>we cannot</u> go into the God's presence.
- If we don't go into the presence of God we cannot grow spiritually,
- Therefore, we shall surly die. (Spiritually speaking)
- That's why when <u>we come to the house of God</u> it is imperative that <u>we</u> <u>worship</u>.
- We need to get our minds off the busy day and get our minds on God.
- We *can't worship God* if our minds are everywhere but here.

### Worship is important. We must have worship

Worship is what brings revival. It brings <u>the power of the Holy Spirit</u> and with <u>the</u> <u>power</u> of the Holy Spirit comes <u>deliverance</u>, <u>peace</u>, and <u>victory</u>.

# That's why the devil wants to hinder our worship

- He will do whatever it takes <u>to distract you</u> to the point that <u>when you get</u> <u>to church</u> you <u>don't</u> feel like worshiping.
- That's how <u>he robs us</u> of **our blessing.**
- Because *worship is what gives us the strength* to get up and go on.
- If we don't worship, we become weak and frail and easy to whip.

#### So, the devil wants to <u>hinder our worship</u>.

- There is an old song we sang when I was first saved: "We have come into His house and gathered in His name to worship Him."
- That is exactly **why** <u>we have gathered here today</u> and <u>there's not a problem</u> or <u>a devil</u> **that's going to** <u>stop us from worshiping God</u>.

This is God's house, and He's worthy of all we can give

**<u>Question</u>: Why did I come to church today? What's my purpose?** 

Did I come to worship God, or did I come for some other reason?

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### First way the devil can bind our worship is through preoccupation.

- If he can *preoccupy your mind* while you are at church, **he can bind your** worship.
- In other words, *if your mind is on something besides God*, <u>you can't</u> <u>worship the Lord</u>

#### How many times has this happened to us?

- We know that <u>we ought to have our minds on God</u> but for some reason <u>our</u> <u>minds are</u> on <u>where we're going to eat lunch</u> after Church.
- Or whether or not we left the stove on or unplugged the iron.

- Or we might be sitting there *thinking about the argument* that we just had.
- Or we might be thinking about <u>what time the game starts</u>, *sure hope the preacher* has a short one today.

# Understand: <u>The devil will fill your mind</u> with anything that will <u>stop your</u> <u>worship</u>.

- Sometimes we even get <u>preoccupied</u> with <u>what everybody in the church</u> <u>thinks about us</u>.
- Am I dressed the right way? Do I fit in? Do I look out of place? Does my hair look OK? Is anybody staring at me?
- Don't forget <u>the reason</u> we're here! We didn't <u>come here to please one</u> <u>another</u>; we came here <u>to please the Lord</u>.

The Bible says in Acts 2:1 - The Coming of the Holy Spirit - On the day of Pentecost all the Lord's followers were together in one place.

- That on the Day of Pentecost that they were in one accord.
- They were <u>not</u> preoccupied. When they came to that Upper Room, *they* had <u>their minds on God</u>.
- They weren't worried about lunch.
- They were <u>only concerned about</u> **pleasing God.**
- They were <u>hungry for God</u> to manifest Himself among them.
- And when we come to Gods house; *if we would somehow occupy ourselves with God*
- *Not preoccupy ourselves* with something else *we would <u>see a greater</u> outpouring of the Holy Spirit*.

All our attention must be on God!!!

• We <u>can't</u> be looking at everybody else and <u>focus on God</u> at the same time.

- We can't scan the church <u>to see who's here</u> and <u>who isn't</u> and still have our minds on God.
- We can't be thinking; oh man, <u>so and so needed that</u>, I sure <u>hope he's</u> <u>listening</u> and still have our minds on God.
- The devil <u>will use any device necessary to preoccupy</u> your mind because that will <u>keep you from worshiping God</u>.
- If we would <u>focus on worship</u> the way <u>we focus on other people</u>, there's **no telling what would happen** in this place.
- We fall for the trick of the devil. <u>Our Worship often dies because</u> we are preoccupied <u>looking at them</u> instead of <u>looking up to HIM</u>.

We must stop allowing the enemy to distract us.

- *If we will go ahead and worship God* instead of <u>looking around</u> and <u>wondering</u> *why somebody bothered coming to church* in the first place.
- We are <u>**not**</u> going to get <u>caught in the devil's trap</u>.
- We're going to keep our eyes on Jesus and worship Him and <u>have a move</u> of the Holy Spirit.

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A second way the devil can bind our worship is through prayerlessness.

- If the devil can keep us from praying, *our worship is nothing* but a ritual.
- The devil's favorite tool to keep us from praying is to get us to think that we're too busy to pray. [We're too busy not to pray]
- The devil will use any tool; he will use <u>the TV</u>, your <u>play time</u>, you job, or even <u>sleep</u>.
- If he can, *he will hinder your prayer life*, <u>because that will</u> bind your worship.
- The devil knows that if you're not praying, you're already whipped.

- When you pray it puts the devil in a panic mode. Because he knows that God answers prayer.
- *That's why the devil tried to hinder prayer* in the Bible in every way he could.

Acts 19:15 - And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?"

• You know why they knew Paul, *because he prayed*?

# When we don't pray it makes the devil's job easy.

### Prayer prepares us for worship!

- We become *aware and sensitive to what God wants*.
- When we pray, we understand what God is trying to tell us.
- The more we pray the more we know Jesus and worship becomes a natural part of our lives.
- <u>The devil wants to bind that because</u> worship will <u>make you an overcomer</u>.
- You will overcome <u>whatever the devil throws at you if</u> you will be <u>earnest</u>, <u>fervent</u>, and <u>consistent</u> *in prayer*.
- **Prayer** <u>gives us liberty to worship</u> at home and at church.

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### <u>A third way</u> the devil can bind our worship is through pride

### <u>Pride</u> is a disease that makes everybody sick but the person who has it.

- Somebody who's proud is *always looking down* on other people.
- As long *as they are looking down*, **they cannot see God** <u>because He is up</u>, so they miss out on the higher and better aspects of life.

• God hates pride!

# He said in Proverbs 8:13 - <u>The fear of the Lord is</u> to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way and the perverse mouth I hate.

# Pride and arrogance, I hate.

• <u>Pride will build a wall</u> between you and God.

**Psalm 138:6** - <sup>6</sup> Though the LORD *is* on high, Yet He regards the lowly; But the proud He knows from afar.

# You <u>can't</u> be close to God and be <u>full of pride</u>.

# We <u>can't be arrogant</u> and be close to God.

- We can't start *thinking of ourselves more highly than we ought to* think and be close to God.
- Pride is a spirit that we must get rid of so that we can be close to God.
- It's hard to crucify the flesh. So how do you do it? Through prayer!

James 4:6 - But He gives more grace. Therefore, He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

### The humble can worship the Lord.

- When we humble ourselves in the house of God and <u>we worship</u>, <u>God will</u> <u>respond</u> to that kind of worship.
- Then He makes us glad. Then we can rejoice.

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# <u>A fourth way</u> that the devil can bind our worship is through prejudice

The devil has used this tool a lot *in order to bind the worship* of some good people.

To have prejudice means that <u>somebody has prejudged somebody else</u> or something else <u>without sufficient facts</u> to make <u>an accurate judgment</u>.

It's sad to say, but *it happens in a lot of churches*. *Folks come to church*, and they have **prejudice** against somebody else.

We cannot fall into the devil's trap and *prejudge somebody who doesn't fit into our predetermined mold*.

- We cannot get caught *judging somebody's spiritual condition*. It <u>doesn't</u> matter how they look.
- We cannot get *preoccupied with prejudice* because *that will bind our worship....*

# That's <u>exactly</u> what the devil wants.

- So that's what we are not going to give him.
- We will just continue to *worship without prejudice*.
- Anybody who *wants to worship with us can*.
- If we can worship <u>without being preoccupied</u>, God's going to move.

*Can I add something?* <u>We cannot be prejudice</u> about **how we think everybody ought to worship**.

• Everybody worships different. If we didn't, we would all be puppets on a string. What good is that to God?

### God wants us to worship Him because we want to, <u>not because</u> we have to.

• It <u>doesn't matter how</u> we worship just so *we worship*. Let's <u>leave the</u> judging to God.

# **1** Samuel **16:7** - *tells us that man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.*

- Everybody has <u>their own unique relationship</u> with God.
- It's our responsibility to come to church with the purpose the desire to worship the Lord *in spirit and in truth*.

# <u>A fifth way that the devil can bind our worship is through presumption</u>

# What does presumption have to do with? It has to do with overstepping, <u>taking</u> <u>for granted</u>.

• If we ever reach the place to where we start thinking that **God is here just because we showed up**, we are badly mistaking.

The devil would like for us to think we can have church with or without God.

- That we can replace God with social activities or whatever.
- <u>We cannot replace</u> the presence of Almighty God.
- If God is not here, then we may as well stay home.

# This church depends on <u>the presence of God</u>.

- Lives are at stake! Families are at stake! Marriages are at stake!
- We must have <u>the presence of God</u> in this church.
- Not only do <u>we need his presence in this church</u>, but **we need to experience** *his presence in our lives*.

Matthew 3:3 - We must <u>prepare</u> the way of the Lord, instead of presuming that He'll show up just because we're here.

- The name on the building doesn't guarantee that God will be here.
- We must <u>prepare</u> for the presence of God. How?
- We need to remove all the unsightly things from our lives. Preparation!
- **<u>Preparing</u>** the way means that the crooked places must be made straight

### Isaiah 40:4 - That all sin be removed from the camp.

- We may have to repent, but <u>whatever it takes</u> to make sure that <u>the</u> presence of God is here is what we ought to be willing to do.
- When we make <u>preparation</u>, there will be <u>a revelation</u> of the glory of God.

# CLOSE:

There are a lot of folks who want to know who Jesus is and they do want to experience His presence for themselves.

<u>They are **hurting**</u>. They are <u>suffering</u> and <u>struggling</u> with life. Just trying to live from one day to the next is a burden.

- What they need *is a church* where *they can come and worship* with liberty.
- They need <u>a church</u> where they can come and <u>feel the presence of God</u> and <u>receive His touch</u> in their life.
- They need <u>a church</u> where <u>their spiritual needs can be met</u>.

#### When we worship in spirit and in truth, we are preparing the way of the Lord

- When His way is <u>prepared</u>, <u>He steps into the service</u> and does a great work in the lives of people.
- The devil <u>can't do anything to stop it</u>.
- *He cannot stop them from* <u>being delivered</u>, <u>set free</u>, <u>cleansed</u>, or <u>made</u> <u>whole</u>.
- We cannot allow the devil to bind our worship, especially now when the need is so great, and Jesus is about to return.

We must worship Him in spirit and in truth
