#### The Transformation of A Mess

First, let's look at how the Merriam-Webster dictionary defines *transformation*: "A complete or major change in someone or something's appearance, form."

Transformation isn't a future event, it's a present-day activity.

It's understandable to think that <u>transformation for Christians means</u> we improve ourselves or our behavior, so we appear *more "Christ-like."* 

Definition of a mess: a situation or state of affairs that is confused or full of difficulties.

If it is not a mess, it is **NOT** progress.

**Genesis 1:1-2** - **The History of Creation** - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

Intro: It has been said that *between vs. 1 and vs. 2 a war took place* in heaven. This war was between Lucifer and God himself.

- We find the story **in Isaiah** of how this battle took place.
- In reality, it was a battle to Satan, but <u>no battle to God</u>.

#### Isaiah 14:12-16 - The Fall of Lucifer

<sup>12</sup> "How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! <sup>13</sup> For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; <sup>14</sup> I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' <sup>15</sup> Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit. <sup>16</sup> "Those who see you will gaze at you, And consider you, saying: 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, Who shook kingdoms,

• Just because **we find this story in Isaiah** <u>does not mean</u> that this is when it took place.

How then could the serpent <u>a type of Lucifer</u> tempt Eve in the Garden?

You can't win against God and His army of angels!

So here we have a created heaven & earth.

• I don't know the difference between the original earth, and this re-created earth we read about between the 1st and 2nd verse of Gen.

Possibly because of <u>the fall of Lucifer</u> the world became <u>a mess</u>.

Definition: a situation or state of affairs that is confused or full of difficulties.

- Because of the mess the earth was without form and void.
- The darkness of sin was upon the face of the earth.
- We could see this as the Face of Lucifer himself. Because Lucifer is sin.

But here is the good part, in vs. 2 it says,

Gen 1:2b - And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

- God got in the Devil's face.
- He started getting in the Devil's business!
- Devil's been hanging out too long on God's created world causing havoc/sin
- It is time for you to move on!

You may say, "Pastor you're reading too much into these Scriptures."

Maybe so, but why did God ask Adam to replenish the earth in Gen. 1:28?

Gen. 1:28a - Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill (replenish) the earth and subdue it.

• That word **replenish** means to **make full again**.

**Ps 51:5** - Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me.

All of us was born a mess. We had no form, no purpose

We all have <u>a void</u> from the very beginning that we try and fill with careers, relationships, money, drugs, alcohol, pleasures of the world, education...

We were living between vs.1 and vs.2 of Gen. Chapter 1.

- Lucifer had us in darkness.
- He controlled our lives from the very beginning.

It was a <u>creative combination</u> that saved us.

## When the Spirit of God moved upon us -

- As He did upon this dark, shapeless, void of the earth
- and then spoke in our lives,
- thus, being the creative combination,
- then and only then was there light.
- God then <u>saw the light</u> and saw that **it was good**.
- He then <u>saw the change in us</u> and saw that it was good.

**He then begins to separate us** from the things of this world as He did in the beginning.

**He then divided the waters** which is <u>a type of us being baptized</u>. We are the **firmament** in the mist of the waters.

He then said let the earth bring forth fruit as He wants us to bring forth fruit of the Spirit.

# He then said he wants the earth to multiply -

• **He wants us** to go and teach and preach and witness to others about this great Gospel so the church can multiply.

<u>Mark 5</u> - tells us about <u>a man filled with darkness</u>, one who <u>did not</u> have any <u>form of God in him</u>.

## Jesus Got in the Devils face... A Demon-Possessed Man Healed

Mark 5:5-8 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones.

<sup>6</sup> When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him. <sup>7</sup> And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me."

<sup>8</sup> For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!"

• Jesus Got in the Devils face...

Mark 5:19b - "Go home to your friends and <u>tell them what great things the Lord</u> has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you."

Just as the old world <u>needed to be recreated</u>, so also do we need to be <u>born</u> again according to John 3:3

**John 3:3** - Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

What happens when we are <u>transformed from a mess of sin</u> to the new birth of Jesus Christ?

**2Co 5:17** – Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

  - ONENESS WITH THE LORD

#### \*A new attitude -

- **2 Corinthians 5:15** And He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.
  - TO LIVE "UNTO HIM" WHO LOVE US

### \*A new activity -

- **2 Corinthians 5:7 -** For we walk by faith, not by sight.
  - TO WALK BY FAITH

#### \*A new ambassador –

- **2 Corinthians 5:20** Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.
  - TO DELIVER THE MESSAGE OF RECONCILIATION

#### \*A new assurance

**2 Corinthians 5:1 - Assurance of the Resurrection -** For we know that if our earthly house, *this* tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
