Relationships - Part One: Understanding Who You Are

Most of us have learned and the Bible teaches us mainly about two things....

- 1. **The first** is our relationship with God.
- 2. **The second** is our relationship with one another.

Every book in the Bible deals with these two relationships.

Almost everything that I talk about from this pulpit concerns <u>our relationship with</u> <u>God</u>. That is a good thing to talk about!

This morning though, I want to <u>begin a new series</u> concerning <u>our relationship</u> <u>with ourselves</u> and <u>with others</u>.

We are going to address relationships that deal with <u>the husband</u>, <u>the wife</u>, <u>friends</u>, and <u>family</u>, <u>communication</u>...but I want to <u>begin this series</u> this morning by talking about **understanding yourself!**

The first key to understanding yourself is to understand...

- Who you are...
- Where you come from...
- Where you are going...
- What your purpose is...

...before you can be successful in any relationship...you must be able to understand yourself!

Before you can be successful *in your relationship with God* you must be able to understand yourself!

Tell the person next to you..."I am about to find out who I am."

The Bible says - James 1:17-18

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and *comes down from the father of lights*, with *whom there is no variation* or shadow of turning. ¹⁸ Of His own will *He brought us forth by the word of truth*, *that we might be a kind of first-fruits of His creatures*. (James, Jesus' half-brother, *wrote this*.)

Very quickly in his writings, he begins to talk about who we are

He begins by stating, "Every perfect gift is from above, from God the one who created light, and from the one who can never change."

James is setting up his *next statement* in this verse.

In the very next verse, James says, "*God brought us to life by His word, and we became His most precious possession.*"

In two verses, James tells you who you are, and where you came from!

God brought you into this world.

- It doesn't matter what the earthly circumstances of your birth were.
- You were not a mistake.
- You were not an accident.
- God put you right where you are for a purpose.
- God brought you into this world.

That's where you came from!

The Bible says that you are a perfect gift from above.

- That cannot change.
- There is no variableness or shadow of turning about that!
- You are the most prized possession of God.
- You are the apple of His eye.

That is who you are today!

Somebody say, "I know who I am!"

Then James goes on to say that it is <u>not good enough to hear</u> who we are, but <u>we must become who we were born to be</u>!

James 1:22-25 - ²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for he observes himself, goes away, and *immediately forgets what kind of man he was*. ²⁵ But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it and* is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, *this one will be blessed in what he does*.

There is a lot to swallow in those four verses!

*James makes it easy for us to understand though...*he compares it to *looking in the mirror*.

How many of you like to look in the mirror? <u>Don't raise your hand</u>.

- **The mirror doesn't lie...**it <u>tells the truth</u> every time.
- I liked the mirror a lot more when I was 25 than I do today.

I looked in the mirror a lot in those days...

Don't laugh at me, you know <u>exactly what I am talking about</u>! *Some of you go back to the mirror* seven, eight, nine and ten times before you leave the house.

It is like **you forgot what you looked like** ten minutes earlier.

That is exactly James' point...

James 1:23-24 - ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for he observes himself, goes away, and *immediately forgets what kind of man he was*.

The reason that some of us struggle so much in our relationships, is because we forget who we are...

But if you forget who you are between <u>now and Sunday</u>, <u>when the enemy starts</u> messing with you...it is <u>not</u> going to do you any good.

James says, some of us are <u>like that person who constantly has to look in the</u> <u>mirror</u> to make sure they are good enough.

You know what your problem is this morning?

- Some you have forgotten what you look like!
- Some of you have forgotten <u>who your father is</u>!
- Some of you don't remember <u>where you came from</u>!

It is time for somebody to go beyond the hearing and start believing.

It is time for somebody to *start becoming who you are*.

James 1:25 –

But <u>whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and</u> <u>continues in it</u>—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—<u>they will be</u> <u>blessed in what they do</u>.

James said, don't look in the mirror, look in the word...the word is your mirror!

*Take it to the next level...*don't just hear the preacher but believe him and put it into action!

- You are the <u>apple of God's eye</u>.
- You are the crown of His creation.
- You are **not** <u>an accident</u>.
- God **didn't** <u>make any mistakes</u>.
- You are a **perfect** gift from God.
- Satan has <u>no</u> power over you.
- The enemy can't mess with you...<u>Unless you let him</u>.

Since you are a perfect gift from God, it is important to <u>understand</u> that <u>you are</u> <u>unique</u>!

There *ain't nobody else* like you in this entire world!

David said... Ps 139:14-16 -

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

¹⁵ My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth.

¹⁶ Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

- You were *fearfully and wonderfully made*.
- God knows every part of you...everything about you was recorded while you were in the womb.

Not only are you unique in creation, but you are also unique in purpose.

God has a *unique purpose* for your life!

- *Nobody* can *take your place*...You are unique.
- Nobody can *talk like you*...**you are unique**.
- Nobody can *sing like you*...**you are unique**.

Isaiah 43:6-7

I will say to the north and to the south, "Free my sons and daughters! Let them return from distant lands.

⁷They are my people—<u>I created each of them to bring honor to me</u>."

We were created for the glory of God!

- **God's glory** is the *beauty and power* of His Spirit.
- We were created then to <u>show God's glory</u>...his beauty and his power...to all the Earth.

That is our purpose!

We are earthly vessels that contain His Glory!

We reveal His Glory to this world <u>through our unique abilities</u>...<u>through our</u> <u>unique characteristics</u> that were given from God.

In other words...<u>I can't sing like my wife</u>...**she reveals Gods glory through song...**the beauty of music. She is unique in that way.

<u>I try to reveal God's glory</u> through the spoken word.

There are many ways *that each one of us can show God's glory* to this world.

• Love for one another – Compassion – Humility - Servant hood.

Another way that we can all show God's glory is *by our testimony*! Our witness!

- Your personality <u>is unique</u>.
- So, your testimony is unique!

You are called to be a witness!

1 Peter 2:9 – ⁹ But <u>you are a chosen generation</u>, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, <u>that you may proclaim the praises of Him who</u> <u>called you out of darkness into His marvelous light</u>;

We are called to show people how He called us out of darkness! We cannot hide our light!

Nobody else can reach the people that you are called to reach...you are unique.

There are a lot of people *that will listen to your testimony*, but they won't listen to my testimony.

- Nobody else goes where you go.
- Nobody else <u>works where you work</u>.
- Nobody else has the friends that you have.

Listen now...and nobody else can witness like you can witness.

God had given you the unique ability to reach the people in your life!

If you don't reach those people...<u>who will reach them</u>... You are the only one who can reach them...<u>you are unique</u>!

God placed you where you are for a purpose.

I can't take your place, and you can't take my place...<u>you are unique</u>.

When I look at my own children...same father...same mother...yet so different...<u>unique</u>.

God made us that way and *<u>He understands our differences</u>*!

Matthew 25:15 - ¹⁵ And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey.

Don't be jealous of the talents that somebody else has...God made them that way.

And if you will use what God has given you...He will bless you with more.

Remember what our text said...

James 1:25 – But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, <u>but doing it—</u> <u>they will be blessed in what they do</u>.

If you start doing what God has created you to do you will be blessed!

So God made each of us unique, and God loves us that way.

His love is unconditional...

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

God's love for you is *unconditional*...we are the object of His affection.

<u>I didn't say</u> that God loves it when you mess up and sin...but His love for you is <u>unconditional</u>.

The important thing is what it really means to understand yourself.

Remember where you came from.

- **Our problem is** that <u>we forget who we are</u>.
- We forget where we came from.
- We forget <u>what our purpose is</u>.

CLOSE: Do you know who you are today?

The reason people backslide is because *they forget who they really are*!

The prodigal son took his inheritance and left his family and home behind.

He erased the memory of his past.

- He became somebody that he was not.
- Instead of <u>staying true</u> to who he was, the Bible says that <u>he joined himself</u> to a citizen of another country.
- He forgot who he was...and <u>became another person</u>, living a life h<u>e did not</u> <u>know</u>.

After a time of living like that, and when his money was all gone, the Bible says...

Luke 15:17 - And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my fathers have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!

When he came to himself...one day he woke up!

One morning....

- He remembered who he used to be ...
- He remembered where he came from...
- He remembered who his father was...

Oh, does anybody remember who your daddy is tonight.

Do you know who you are?

It dawned on the prodigal that <u>he needed to go back home</u>...even if it had to be as a servant.

So, he heads back home to his father...

Luke 15:20-24 - 20 And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.

21 And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.

22 But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet:

23 And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat, and be merry: 24 For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry.

You might not think you are worthy to be called a child of God today...but if you will just **give God a chance**...

- **He will** bring out <u>the best robe</u>.
- He will bring out <u>the fatted calf</u>.
- He will throw <u>a grand celebration</u>.

...because you are one of His...<u>a child of the King of Kings</u> and the Lord of Lords! <u>He loves you</u> more than anything.

- *Do you remember* who you are tonight?
- Do you remember when God baptized you with the Holy Ghost and fire.
- Do you remember when you took on His name at baptism.

You have been *purchased with the blood* of Jesus Christ, and <u>you are not your</u> <u>own</u>.... he is <u>Abba Father to you</u>!

It is time for somebody to start being who God called you to be today!
