Outside The Box Series #4 - Outside The Box <u>Grace</u>

To understand God's grace is to understand <u>Outside The Box Grace</u>.

<u>Grace used as a noun</u> (Christian belief) the *free and unmerited favor of God*, as manifested in the salvation of sinners and the bestowal of blessings.

• The condition or fact of being favored by someone.

Used as a verb, do honor or credit to (someone or something) by one's presence.

Grace is a <u>terribly misunderstood</u> word.

- Detailed *theology textbooks* **do not** offer any concise definition of the term.
- Someone proposed an acronym: GRACE is God's Riches At Christ's Expense.
- That's <u>not a bad way</u> to <u>characterize grace</u>, but *it is <u>not</u> a sufficient theological definition*.

One well known definitions of grace is only three words: God's unmerited favor.

<u>A. W. Tozer</u> expanded on that: "Grace is the good pleasure of God that inclines him to bestow benefits on the undeserving."

- Grace is not merely unmerited favor; *it is favor bestowed on sinners* who deserve wrath.
- Showing kindness to a stranger is "unmerited favor"; but doing good to one's enemies is more <u>the spirit of grace</u>.

<u>GODS GREAT GRACE</u> - <u>Acts 4:33</u> – NKJV - ³³ And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And <u>great grace</u> was upon them all.

I believe that *God wants to* put on you, your life, and your family...

• AND ON <u>YOUR FAILURE</u> today... <u>GREAT GRACE</u>!!!!

Mistakes are the price we pay for a full life, if we learn from those mistakes!

- The issue is <u>NOT</u> if you're going to <u>get knocked down</u>. The issue is *Are you* going to <u>stay down</u>?
- Timex said You have to take a licking and keep on ticking!

The word is called *resilience* in the dictionary –

- <u>The capacity</u> to recover quickly from difficulties; (toughness)
- The ability to spring back into shape; (elasticity)
- <u>RESILIENCE</u> is what matters most!!!

<u>Grace is not</u> a one-time event in the Christian experience. We stand in grace.

Romans 5:2 NKJV - through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:2 CEV - Christ has also introduced us to God's gift of undeserved grace on which we now take our stand.

The entire Christian life is driven and empowered by grace:

Hebrews 13:9 CEV - It is better to receive strength from <u>God's gift of undeserved</u> grace than to depend on certain foods.

To understand <u>God's grace</u> is to understand <u>Outside The Box Grace</u>.

Mistakes are the catalyst to the miraculous...

- IF you will **<u>put them in God's hands</u>**! Don't let <u>*mistakes destroy you*</u>
- Heaven wants to make you Hell wants to maim you
- And **both** want to **use your mistakes** to do it!!!

The adversary wants to mock and maim you for the rest of your life

- For the mistakes you have made, and <u>we have made them</u>!!!
- God *can transform you* through your *mistakes*
- To be *what He wants* you to be!
- Mistakes should not maim us the rest of our lives.

Mistakes can become prison houses that hold you hostage.

- The enemy would love for all of us who have made mistakes
- To be held hostage in a prison...
- *Mentally, emotionally, spiritually <u>By the Mistakes</u> that we have made!*

Great Grace only comes after Great Mistake!

- The greater the mistake -The greater God's grace comes to all of us.
- I didn't come with any <u>bad news today</u>.
- All I came with today is <u>GREAT GRACE</u>....

Point #1 YOU MAY HAVE MADE A MISTAKE, BUT <u>YOU ARE NOT ONE</u>.

Let that <u>sink down into your soul</u> when the enemy is beating your brains out!

- **Telling you are** trash, stupid, nothing, how could you be so dumb, how could you mess your life up so bad...
- You may have made a mistake, but YOU ARE NOT ONE !!!
- You may have <u>failed</u> but your <u>NOT A FAILURE</u>

You DON'T have to be <u>a prisoner</u> to your mistake...

- You may <u>be down</u>, but **DOWN IS NOT** <u>YOUR DESTINY</u>...
- God has <u>grace</u> for your mistakes!!!

God still has a great plan and purpose for your life.

- He still has GREAT GRACE FOR GREAT MISTAKES!!!!
- You will experience a <u>RESURRECTION</u>, You will COME OUT OF THIS.

Mistakes can become <u>a doorway to discover possibilities</u> you would not have found without your mistake!

- A portal of possibilities you would have never discovered had you not gone through <u>the mistake</u>.
- I'm **NOT advocating** go out and make mistakes so you can learn more about God's Grace.
- I'm just telling you <u>what the devil</u> means to <u>destroy</u> you with, <u>imprisoned</u> you with, <u>defeat</u> you with, and <u>humiliate</u> you with......
- God says, I Can PUT GREAT GRACE on your GREAT MISTAKE!!!
- <u>THEN they become a doorway</u> of possibilities <u>to discover</u> That your failure, your Mistakes <u>are NOT final</u>!!!

That is why Nahum said: <u>Micah7:8</u> – NKJV - <u>Do not rejoice over me</u>, my enemy; When I fall, <u>I will arise</u>; When I sit in darkness, <u>The Lord will be a light to me</u>.

- You will see me mess up
- **Don't** you start <u>throwing a party</u>
- Don't start rejoicing over me oh my enemies...
- For when I FALL, I WILL RISE AGAIN
- Even I sit in darkness, It Is NOT FOREVER HIS LIGHT WILL find me again ©
- **<u>DO NOT</u> let Failure** <u>become final</u> in your life.
- Hidden in every mistake is a doorway of possibility to discover.
- He <u>doesn't</u> want our <u>Mistake to be a prison</u> <u>But a pathway</u> to a greater revelation of <u>His GRACE</u>.....

Point #2

GOD WILL NEVER DEFINE YOU BY YOUR WORST MISTAKE.

- <u>People will</u>, your <u>critics will</u>, your enemies will <u>define you</u> for the rest of your life, by your <u>mistakes</u>!
- YOUR GOD will <u>Never define you</u> by the worst mistake you've made.
- God says "I blot out your transgressions." Remember them NO MORE
- I'll never <u>define you</u> by your <u>worst mistake</u>. <u>NEVER</u> will God EVER DO THAT!!!!

Elder Brother Spirits will! (Luke 15:11-24)

- The only one to <u>bring up the past</u> of the prodigal son Was the Older Brother.
- The Father <u>never said a word</u> about it... He just threw a coat on him, <u>covered him up</u>, <u>brought him home</u>
- Threw a party, got the <u>musicians</u> out, danced...
- <u>The older Brother</u> was just sitting over their <u>wanting to discuss the Past</u>...
- God will <u>never</u> define you by your worst mistake...

DON'T JOIN THE DEVIL'S SIDE

- He is *the accuser* of the brethren. Stop defining people *by their mistakes*
- God will never define you by your worse moment.
- Mistakes and failures *do have consequences* no doubt about it.
- But they are not supposed to define your future

Heaven wants to make you; Hell wants to Maim you!

God, in order to conform us into his image, <u>let's us fail</u> so we can come to the end of <u>ourselves</u> and <u>our self-righteousness</u>.

- The devil desires to crush you for your mistakes.
- Make you feel unworthy and worthless
- When in reality you are a precious child of God.
- Satan wants you to feel totally worthless.
- Hell wants to <u>chain you</u>. Heaven wants to <u>conform you</u>.

DO YOU FEEL CHAINED TO A PAST MISTAKE – YOU SHOULDN'T!!!!!

Mistakes make you feel stupid – You often think how could of <u>I did</u>, <u>thought</u>, or <u>given in to that</u>.

• What an *idiot*, then you begin *to beat yourself up*!

Abraham made a terrible mistake, lied about his wife

- Made <u>another mistake</u> when he <u>slept with a woman</u> that wasn't his wife
- That's terrible... But, <u>God never brought it up</u>, not one time.
- Even though he made mistakes, God said go on, move on...
- I'm still going to *make you* The Father of Faith
- I know you messed up, but I'm not defining you by your mistake.
- You made a mistake, but you are <u>NOT a Mistake</u>. AND I'm going to <u>use you</u> for my glory!!!!

Point #3

GOD USES MISTAKES TO TAKE US BEYOND

- How is it that we can <u>make one mistake</u> and *people will <u>define you by that</u>* <u>one mistake</u>.
- Even *over all the good* we have done for the Lord!
- God will never bring up <u>your failure</u>...
- He wants you to <u>move beyond your mistakes</u>, And into HIS <u>GREAT</u> <u>GRACE</u>!!!

The people we almost make deity's out of in the bible.

- Jacob Lied and deceived –
- **David** committed adultery, killed people, he did horrible things...

<u>The Point</u> – God <u>uses people</u> who make mistakes.

God said to Jacob, you're <u>a scam artist</u>, you're <u>a liar</u>, you're <u>a deceiver</u>, you've done about <u>all the bad things</u> you can do.

You're a liar, a luster, you're a looser....

- But I'm going to make you a Prince, I will re-name you
- You no longer will be Jacob, you will become Israel.
- Which means *a Prince with God*
- I'm going to give you *power* with God and *favor* with men...

I love the fact that <u>Peter messed up</u>

- He lied, cussed, and denied Jesus three times.
- When Jesus showed up in *his Resurrected body* an cooked him a meal...
- Jesus didn't look at him and say give me the keys back...
- He said, <u>I give you</u> Peter <u>the keys to the Kingdom</u>! Just because <u>you</u> <u>messed up</u> and <u>made a mistake</u>.....
- Jesus has never said for you to give the keys back!!!

Jesus is saying to us today, I haven't changed my mind about you, your purpose, and your destiny!

- He's telling us, I knew you would mess up
- But I Put GREAT GRACE ON GREAT MISTAKES
- If you just <u>look to me</u>, I NEVER <u>GIVE UP ON YOU</u> YOUR <u>MISTAKES ARE</u> <u>NOT</u> FINAL!!!!

Point #4

DON'T LET YOUR MISTAKES <u>HOLD YOU HOSTAGE</u>!!!

- You *will not* be able to even <u>praise the Lord</u>!
- *Condemnation* does not come from God.
- God will use you anyways!

I've made so many mistakes Pastoring this church....

- God has never come to me and said give me the keys back !!!
- People may want to... God said, NO I've gave you what I've gave you.
- I like you, love you, l'm for you!!! He's saying the same thing about you 😳

<u>Psalm 38:16</u> – NKJV - ¹⁶ For I said, *"Hear me,* lest they rejoice over me, Lest, <u>when my foot slips</u>, they exalt *themselves* against me."

He didn't say *if* – He says *WHEN* My Foot Slips!

- You're going to slip and *say or do something* you shouldn't.
- You are going to *make a mistake*.

I love how *his enemies wait to pounce on him*, but he goes on to say.

<u>Psalm 38:18</u> - NKJV - ¹⁸ For <u>*I will declare my iniquity*</u>; I will be in anguish over my sin.

Declare means – open your mouth and tell God, *I MADE A MISTAKE*.

You move from admission to remission.

- If cancer is in remission It means it is losing its power.
- When you come with admission I MADE A MISTAKE
- Then suddenly that Mistake goes into REMISSION
- You go from **Declaration** to **Restoration**
- You go from *declaring I'm guilty* and *God pronounces your innocent*
- <u>MY BLOOD</u> HAS COVERED YOU!!!

Wish I would have handled it differently!

- The devil wants to *magnify your mistake*
- God wants to <u>Magnify Himself</u> during <u>your mistake</u>!!!
- I will not let <u>my mistakes</u> define me...

I am a child of God

- <u>Called</u>, <u>anointed</u>, and *I'm going to do what he has called me to do*
- With *more determination* and *boldness* than ever before!!!
- Yes I've messed up Yes I've made Mistakes BUT

My mistakes DON'T DEFINE ME MY HEAVENLY FATHER DEFINES ME

- AND HE SAYS, <u>I'M CALLED</u>, I AM <u>CHOOSEN</u>, I AM <u>ROYALTY</u>, I AM <u>CLEANSED</u>, I AM <u>WASHED</u>, AND <u>REDEEMED</u>......
- How ABOUT YOU??????
- GIVE GOD A PRAISE IF YOU BELIEVE IN GREAT GRACE ©
- THE <u>GREATER THE MISTAKE</u> THE <u>GREATER THE GRACE</u>!!!!!!

CLOSE: God is greater than your mistakes, your failures, your wrong choices.....

The Bible says we need both Grace and Mercy

• There is <u>a difference</u> in **Grace and Mercy**

GRACE GIVES ME WHAT <u>I DON'T DESERVE</u> - <u>I DON'T DESERVE</u>:

- Forgiveness, acceptance, a clean slate, a new beginning.
- Grace is <u>God giving me what I don't deserve</u>! <u>Total forgiveness</u>...
- There is a difference in grace giving me what I don't deserve & Mercy

MERCY HOLDS BACK WHAT *I DO DESERVE*

What's powerful is when you have Grace and Mercy working for you!

- Grace giving you what you don't deserve...
- AND Mercy holding back what you do deserve.
- Judgement you do deserve God stands like he held the Red Sea
- Pass on through <u>Goodness and mercy</u> are following you!
- Goodness, you hold that side of judgement Mercy you hold that side back
- I'll hold back what you do deserve And give you what you don't deserve!

It's hard to misdirect a parked car -

<u>THE ONLY PEOPLE</u> WHO DO NOT FAIL ARE PEOPLE WHO DON'T TRY TO DO MUCH.

If you're trying to be great at anything you're going to fail, because it is hard to misdirect a parked car!

- So, these people who sit back and *judge everybody by their mistakes*
- Usually *aren't* doing very much themselves.
- It's *better to fail trying* than *not trying* at all.

Psalm 145:8 NKJV - ⁸ The LORD *is* **gracious** and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy.

- Listen to me if you have messed up or made a mistake.
- Made the wrong choice, done something that was foolish...
- THE LORD IS GRACIOUS FULL OF COMPASSION.
- SLOW <u>TO ANGER</u> <u>GREAT IN MERCY</u>

Psalm 145:14 – **NKJV** - ¹⁴ The **LORD** upholds all who fall, And raises up all who are bowed down.

You may make a mistake – BUT <u>YOU ARE NOT</u> A MISTAKE

Your Mistakes are NOT greater than God's GRACE ©

<u>Altar Call</u>: This the message we carry as an <u>Outside the Box Church when it come</u> <u>to Grace</u>!

If we can ever become a church *that extends Grace*, *we will be a revival church*!

Gods got more grace than your disgrace – And God will NOT define you by your worst mistake.

You have *two thieves* trying to steal your today—

- <u>Someday</u> is not *for you to worry about*.
- You are blessed right now in THIS moment!

Don't worry about tomorrow and **don't live in regret for yesterday.**
