Can These Bones Live?

Ezekiel 37:1-10 - (NIV) - The Valley of Dry Bones

37 The hand of the Lord was on me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the Lord and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. ² He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. ³ He asked me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

I said, "Sovereign Lord, you alone know."

⁴ Then he said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! ⁵ This is what the Sovereign Lord says to these bones: I will make breath (<u>The Hebrew for this word can also mean wind or spirit</u>) enter you, and you will come to life. ⁶ I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the Lord.'"

⁷ So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. ⁸ I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them.

⁹ Then he said to me, "Prophesy to the breath; prophesy, son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Come, breath, from the four winds and breathe into these slain, that they may live.'" ¹⁰ So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army.

*Ezekiel's vision of the valley of dry bones came to him after God had directed him to prophesy the rebirth of Israel in chapter 36.

This promise seemed impossible in light of Israel's present condition.

- She was "dead" as a nation,
- **<u>Deprived</u>** of her <u>land</u>, her <u>king</u>, and her <u>temple</u>.
- She had been <u>divided and dispersed</u> for so long that *unification and restoration seemed impossible*.
- So <u>God gave Ezekiel the vision</u> of the dry bones <u>as a sign</u>.

<u>Ezek. 37:1</u> - The hand of the Lord was on me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the Lord and set me in *the middle of a valley;* <u>it was full of bones</u>.

- **<u>Probably a battle field...</u>** the dead, slain, bodies of warriors who have long since been forgotten...
- <u>They were probably very strong</u> in there time but now only scattered bones!

<u>Ezek. 37:2</u> - He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, <u>bones that were very dry</u>.

White, bleached, brittle, even the worms <u>wouldn't</u> inhabit these bones now...

- Here is the life that is without God.
- Here is the life that is wasted.
- Here is the life that has <u>no hope</u>.
- **Drugs** have left it desolate.
- Alcohol has broken it to pieces.
- The improper relationship has caused it to be without hope.
- Sin has destroyed it.
- Hopelessness is all around it.
- Despair surrounds it.
- Unhappiness overwhelms it.
- <u>Dejected</u> by its former self.
- <u>Depressed</u> by its current condition.
- Discouraged by its failures.
- <u>Disheartened Disappointed Destitute</u>
- It has *no hope* of ever returning to *its previous glory*.

And so, they're abandoned!!!

• Even the man of God <u>would not have known</u> where they were if <u>God Himself</u> <u>would not have showed</u> these bones to Him.

<u>Ezek. 37:3</u> - He asked me, "Son of man, <u>can these bones live?</u>" I said, "Sovereign Lord, you alone know."

- Even the preacher had **no hope** for these slain.
- So He says "Only you know God"!

If they were to live, he realized that it was going to take a real move of God.

- It's a wise man who realizes he needs God!
- When you come to *that conclusion*, your half way home!

<u>Ezek. 37:4</u> - Then he said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, <u>'Dry</u> bones, hear the word of the Lord!

The dry bones represented the people's spiritually dead condition!!!

- Stop listening to other voices...listen to God
- We need to get into a place where we can hear His Word!!!
- What makes us think <u>we can overcome this world</u> and it's influences <u>without</u> His word?

<u>Heb. 4:12</u> - <u>For the word of God is alive and active.</u> Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

- The Word of God is living, life-changing, and dynamic as it works in us!
- God's Word reveals who we are and what we are not!
- We must not only listen to the Word; we must also let it shape our lives.

<u>Ezek. 37:5</u> - This is what the Sovereign Lord says to these bones: <u>I will make (or Cause)</u> breath enter you, and <u>you will come to life</u>.

- The <u>Hebrew</u> for this word can also mean <u>wind or spirit</u>
- Only God can <u>truly deliver you</u> from some things...

He said "I will cause".

When you give your heart over to Him He goes to work on you.

- You couldn't work hard enough to get that raise...but all of a sudden <u>God</u> <u>blesses you financially!</u>
- You **couldn't love enough** to keep your marriage...but all of a sudden **God is** melting your hearts together.
- You couldn't believe enough to be healed...then all of a sudden <u>He Heals</u>
 You!!!
- You couldn't live good enough to save yourself...So <u>He dies on the tree and</u>
 Saves You!

God said He would Do it.

- He would **Save you** He would **Heal you**. He would **Deliver you**.
- He would **Help you**.

When we forsake our own abilities and seek God's help!

<u>Ezek. 37:6</u> - I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. **Then you will know that I am the Lord.'**

- This is the reason God has brought us to this place in life...
- That we might know Him!!!
- The reason **He has allowed** us to make such a mess of our lives –
- Is so that He could show us who He is!!!

<u>Ezek. 37:7</u> - So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, <u>there</u> <u>was a noise</u>, <u>a rattling sound</u>, and <u>the bones</u> came together, <u>bone to bone</u>.

When God begins to *put a life back together* there is a noise.

- It might take **some shaking up**.
- It might take you finding yourself at the end of your rope.
- Or at the bottom of the pit.

"When you've hit rock bottom the only- way to look is up!!!"

<u>Ezek. 37:8</u> - I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them.

They looked like soldiers...<u>but they weren't soldiers</u>!!!

They looked like Christians...

- But in reality they were **just dried up bones** covered in <u>flesh</u>
- No <u>life!</u> No <u>breath of God!</u> No <u>Holy Spirit!</u> No <u>Power!</u> No <u>anointing!</u>

Acts 1:8 - Jesus said that - "<u>you will</u> receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you!"

- The "POWER" <u>believers receive</u> from the Holy Spirit includes <u>courage</u>, <u>boldness</u>, <u>confidence</u>, <u>insight</u>, <u>ability</u>, and <u>authority</u>!!!
 Jesus had instructed his disciples to witness to people of all nations about him...
- But they were **told to wait** first *for the Holy Spirit*!!!

<u>Ezek. 37:9</u> – Then he said to me, "Prophesy to the breath; prophesy, son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: **Come, breath, <u>from the four winds</u>** and breathe into these slain, that they may live.'

When <u>real</u> revival comes into your life it will come from <u>all directions</u>.

Did you hear me? ... all directions!!!

- I'm talking about a God who can heal broken marriages.
- He can heal and diseased bodies.
- He can bless your **finances**.
- He can **save** your children.
- He can **deliver** you from addictions.
- He can bless you on your job.
- He can help you pay your bills.

When His blessings flow - - - - they flow from every direction!!!!

- He said **whatsoever you bind** in earth shall be bound in heaven.
- He said ask and it shall be given
- He said ask and you shall receive.

<u>Ezek. 37:10</u> – So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and <u>stood up on their feet—a vast army.</u>

If you don't <u>stand for something</u> you will stand for nothing...

It's time for we <u>the church</u> of **the living God** to get into formation – **Fall into the ranks and rise to the occasion** that has been set before us.

Exceeding great army!!!

<u>Not</u> a wish-washy-<u>always-looking-for-the-easy-way-out</u> church with <u>no spiritual</u> <u>back bone or holy tenacity</u> that doesn't know how to <u>pray and touch God</u>.

Close:

We are called to be an exceeding great church!!!

- We should be a church like the world has never seen before!!!
- We should have services that are bar none
- When someone <u>visits</u> our church, <u>they should have an experience with the</u> <u>lord</u> that <u>they will never</u> forget.

- Isn't it time that <u>we allow the presence</u> of God to become a living, breathing, touching, moving

***Coca-Cola 1990 Slogan - "You can't Beat The Real Thing!"

The reviving of the dry bones signified <u>God's plan</u> for Israel's future national restoration.

The vision also, and most importantly, showed that <u>Israel's new life depended</u> on God's power and not the circumstances of the people.

Putting "breath" by God's Spirit into the bones showed that <u>God would not only</u> <u>restore them physically but also spiritually.</u>

These Bones responded!!!
