### Has life ever dealt you a hard blow? Got any enemies? Limitations? Don't Go Anywhere!!!

# 2 Samuel 22:1-8 - NIV - David's Song of Praise

**22** David sang to the Lord the words of this song when the Lord delivered him from the hand of all his enemies and from the hand of Saul. <sup>2</sup> He said:

**"The Lord is my rock**, my fortress, and my deliverer; <sup>3</sup> *my God is my rock*, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation.

He is my stronghold, my refuge and my savior—from violent people you save me. <sup>4</sup> "I called to the Lord, who is worthy of praise, and have been saved from my enemies.

<sup>5</sup> The waves of death swirled about me; the torrents of destruction overwhelmed me. <sup>6</sup> The cords of the grave coiled around me; the snares of death confronted me. <sup>7</sup> "In my distress I called to the Lord; I called out to my God. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came to his ears. <sup>8</sup> The earth trembled and quaked, the foundations of the heavens shook; they trembled because he was angry.

**David** had killed <u>a lion</u>, <u>a bear</u> and <u>a giant</u> as a young boy.

• Invincibility of youth?

David's enemies had taught him his strengths, limitations and God's character.

• Age and experience ought to make us wiser.

# It is this same man who said,

**Psalm 37:25** – <sup>25</sup> I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or <u>their children</u> (*descendants*) begging bread.

2 Samuel 22 is a Psalm and is found in Psalm 18 ....

# <u>Psalm 18:1-6</u> – For the director of music. Of David the servant of the Lord. He sang to the Lord the words of this song when the Lord delivered him from the hand of all his enemies and from the hand of Saul. He said:

<sup>1</sup>I love you, Lord, my strength. <sup>2</sup> The Lord is <u>my rock</u>, <u>my fortress</u> and <u>my</u> <u>deliverer</u>; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my <u>shield</u> (sovereign) and the <u>horn</u> (strength) of my salvation, my stronghold. <sup>3</sup>I called to the Lord, who is worthy of praise, and I have been saved from my enemies. <sup>4</sup>The cords of death entangled me; the torrents of destruction overwhelmed me.

<sup>5</sup> The cords of the grave coiled around me; the snares of death confronted me.
<sup>6</sup> In my distress I called to the Lord; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears.

In *Psalm 18* – David shares <u>the solutions</u> to <u>three major problems</u> we all face.

**1st the PROBLEM** - then David's **<u>SOLUTION</u>** - He uses three (*3) metaphors in three* (*3) different ways* in verses 2 and 3.

*First Problem*: Things Tend to Become Unstable.

- Volatile, Unsecured Things degenerate not visa versa.
- Just when you think <u>you have got a grip</u> POW!

To realize just how much you need an anchor you need <u>the stress of a storm</u>.

- If you <u>aren't anchored</u> <u>you drift</u>.
- If you are <u>anchored to the wrong thing</u> you drift with it.
- When you are <u>anchored to the ocean floor</u> you only go where the ocean's floor goes!

Solution: "The Lord is my <u>Rock</u>"

Three Important Rocks in Scripture:

1. God, a Rock or Foundation

**Psalm 40:2** - He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock, *And* established my steps.

2. Christ, the smitten Rock

<u>1 Corinthians 10:4</u> - And all drank the same spiritual drink. *For they drank of that spiritual Rock* that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.

# 3. Christ, the Foundation of the church

<u>Matthew 16:18</u> - And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hell shall not prevail against it.

#### Second Problem: No One Can Stand the Constant Stresses of Life Alone.

Life is much like ocean waves, if you get knocked down, they won't stop to let you get your breath.

- We all need a "safe place" and place to hide.
- Things that <u>"seem" to give us a break</u> often deceive us.
- Drugs, alcohol, sex....

#### Solution: "The Lord is my <u>Fortress</u>" (stronghold – fort – hiding place) Fortress, a place of strength and safety!!!!!

Jeremiah 16:19 - O Lord, <u>my strength</u> and <u>my fortress</u>, <u>My refuge</u> in the day of affliction, The Gentiles shall come to You From the ends of the earth and say, "Surely our fathers have inherited lies, Worthlessness and unprofitable *things*."

#### Third Problem: We Get in too Deep to get Ourselves Back Out

#### Knowing how to get into trouble comes <u>naturally</u>!

- <u>No practice needed</u> but the more we practice the better we get at it!
- I need a "rescue."

#### Solution: "The Lord is my <u>Deliverer</u>" - ONE who causes one to escape

**<u>Psalm 144:2</u>** – My goodness, and **my fortress**; my high tower, and **<u>my deliverer</u>**; my shield, and he in whom I trust; who subdues my people under me.

- "<u>My deliverer</u>," *Rescuing me in my time of need.*
- "My God;" this is <u>all good things</u> in one. It means, my <u>perpetual</u>, <u>unchanging</u>, <u>infinite</u>, <u>eternal God</u>.
- "<u>My strength</u>;" this really means "*my rock,*" *strength,* My <u>sure</u>, <u>unchanging</u>, <u>eternal confidence</u> and <u>support</u>.

**Psalm 121:1 - God the Help of Those Who Seek Him -** *I will lift up my eyes to the hills—From where does my help come.* 

**Buckler, shield, defender -** God covers the head and the heart so that neither is wounded by the darts from the enemy.

#### Proverbs 2:7 - NKJV

<sup>7</sup> He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; *He is* a <u>shield</u> to those who walk uprightly.

The horn of salvation - Horns are frequently *used in Scripture as a symbol of power,* hence this means a powerful salvation.

**Psalm 132:17** - There I will make <u>the horn</u> of David grow; I will prepare a lamp for My Anointed.

High tower - signifies a place so high as to be out of danger.

#### THE PROBLEM: No One Can Stand the Constant Stresses of Life Alone

#### THE SOLUTION: The Lord is my Rock.

#### But you've got to remember..

- This is the God who *divided the red sea* for Israel.
- This is the God who *swallowed up Pharaoh* and his army.
- This is the God who *caused Jericho's walls to fall down*.
- This is no ordinary God: He's the one who answers by fire.
- He is an awesome God!

#### Let me help you <u>understand</u> something today.

• It's not you that the devil is afraid of. And it is not me.

#### But we have a God who Loves us.

- And *cares for us*. Who became flesh *only to die for us*.
- And at his disposal <u>can</u> and <u>will</u> **dispatch a legion of angels to aid you** in your time of need.

# And my Bible tells me that the devil trembles when I call on this God's name.

- How I love the Name of Jesus.
- For there is **no other name under heaven** given among men where we must be saved.
- For it is at the mention of that name that <u>every devil in hell must surrender</u> his power and his authority.
- Is it any wonder that we are told in the scripture *to baptize in that name*?!
- Is it any wonder that the bible tells us *to pray in that name*?!
- <u>Somebody right now</u> needs to call upon that name of Jesus!!!

# When you've got Jesus, you've got all the power in the world to defeat any spiritual wickedness

- You've got the authority to bring down spiritual darkness.
- No *evil spirits* can touch you.
- No <u>spell</u> can hold you.
- No <u>witchcraft</u> can bind your happiness.

# All you need is Jesus!

- All you need is *the touch of God* upon your life.
- All you need is *the Holy Spirit*.
- <u>The gift</u> of God.
- Just a bent knee at *an altar of repentance*.
- Just a humble heart *seeking help from a loving God*!

# How many know this afternoon...

 If you're going to make it in this ungodly world, it's going to take <u>a</u> <u>relationship with Jesus</u>!

# Paul said "O that I may know him"

- Don't you want to know him today?
- **Don't you** want to <u>experience Him</u> in your life.
- You've heard about Him from others but isn't it time you let Him into your own heart?

That's the wonderful thing about belonging to such a good church as this.

- Here you have fellow believers who will pray with you.
