Believer's Boot Camp - Part 3

Ephesians 3:2 - ² if indeed you have heard of the <u>dispensation</u> of the grace of God which was given to me for you, *("dispensation" – "administration"* (Paul's role to the Gentiles) **CEV** - **You have surely heard about God's gift of undeserved** grace in choosing me to help you.

"The administration of God's grace" – He had been assigned the special work of preaching the gospel to the gentiles, and so are we!!!

The Lord Jesus Christ <u>has already defeated our Enemy</u> hands down.

However, <u>He has left it up to us to enforce</u> every day in earth's trenches <u>the</u> <u>victory He has won</u> in the Heavens.

The book of Ephesians serves as a Believers Boot Camp, teaching us that the church is equipped with vast spiritual weaponry to accomplish this very task.

- <u>Victory</u> is ours <u>if we fight</u> for it!
- Ephesians is serious training for serious Christians.

<u>When people become Christians</u> one of the <u>hardest things</u> to do is to <u>RETRAIN</u> them <u>not to continue</u> to operate according to <u>the world's system</u>.

It took one night to get Israel out of Egypt, but forty years to get Egypt out of them.

There is always a battle between the NEW MAN and the OLD MAN. And that is why we need teaching like Paul gives to us in Ephesians.

The attitude of <u>WORSHIP</u> we walk in daily is the classroom of the Holy Spirit.

The more we cultivate a worshipful life, the more He can teach us His ways.

- As we grow up in the Lord, we UNDERSTAND more, and we SURRENDER more.
- As we remain faithful to God's Word and follow the leading of His Spirit
- We will give up *idols*, put off <u>sinful thinking</u>, and <u>crucify the flesh</u> over and repeatedly!
- As we reach new **<u>Revelation</u>** about God, **<u>our worship</u>** becomes <u>**RICHER**</u>.

When we consider **worship** in light of Ephesians, we can see **why Paul waits until <u>chapter three</u>** to declare that **he is a <u>PRISONER</u>**.

Worship is different than praise!

Because the worshipper has stepped beyond praising God <u>FOR THEIR</u> <u>CONDITION</u> to worshipping Him <u>FROM THEIR POSITION</u>.

Paul <u>wasn't forced</u> to be a prisoner of Jesus – <u>he chose to become that</u>!

WORSHIP IS NOT ACCOMPLISHED IN "SERVICES" – RATHER, WORSHIP IS OUR "SERVICE" TO GOD.

- The **MESSAGE** is far more important than the **MESSENGER**.
- In fact, *the messenger's life is* just a <u>CANVAS</u> for the message.

From the first moment of <u>his encounter with the Lord</u>, **Paul <u>signed up</u> for** hardships.

Acts 9:5 NKJV And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads."

Acts 9:5 AMP Saul said, who are You, Lord? And He said, I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is dangerous and it will turn out bad for you to keep kicking against the goad (*to offer vain and perilous resistance*.)

Acts 9:16 I will show him how much he must suffer for worshiping in my name."

Ephesians 3 - Paul's Mission to the Gentiles - 3:1 *Christ Jesus made me his prisoner, so I could help you Gentiles.*

Paul was under house arrest in Rome for preaching about Christ.

Paul maintained **his firm belief that God was in control** of all history, *including all that happened to him*!

? Do circumstances make you wonder if God has lost control of this world?

Remember no matter what happens, God is still in control!!!

Paul had a *Jewish PEDIGREE*, but he became a <u>PRISONER</u> on behalf of Gentiles <u>he</u> wouldn't have even spoken to before <u>he knew Jesus Christ</u>!

3:2-3 2 You have surely heard about God's gift of undeserved grace in choosing me to help you. 3 In fact, this letter tells you a little about how God has shown me his <u>mysterious ways</u>.

The church is "<u>THE MYSTERY</u>" – the carnal mind <u>cannot</u> understand it – <u>unbelievers are supposed to</u> think teachings of Scripture are <u>ridiculous</u>!

1 Corinthians 2:14 - This is why only someone who has God's Spirit can understand spiritual blessings. <u>Anyone who doesn't have God's Spirit</u> thinks these blessings are foolish.

3:4 As you read the letter, you will also find out how well I really do understand <u>the mystery</u> about Christ.

In scripture, a mystery is not something "hidden", but something "revealed."

That is why <u>a lifestyle of worship is foundational</u> - And <u>non-negotiable</u> because <u>it brings revelation to you</u>!

3:5 No one knew about this mystery <u>until God's Spirit told it</u> to his holy apostles and prophets.

• We are highly **PRIVELEGED** to live in the **CHURCH AGE.**

3:6 And the mystery is this: Because of Christ Jesus, the good news has given <u>the</u> <u>Gentiles</u> a share in the promises <u>God gave to the Jews</u>. God has also <u>let the</u> <u>Gentiles be part of the same body</u>.

• GOD BROKE ALL PROTOCOL IN SAVING THE GENTILES!

Luke 14:16-24 - 16 Jesus told him: A man once gave a great banquet and <u>invited</u> a lot of guests. 17 When the banquet was ready, he sent a servant to tell the guests, "Everything is ready! Please come." 18 *One guest after another started making excuses*. The first one said, "I bought some land, and I've got to look it over. Please excuse me." 19 Another guest said, "I bought five teams of oxen, and I need to try them out. Please excuse me." 20 Still another guest said, "I've just now married, and I can't be there."

21 The servant told his master what happened, and <u>the master became so angry</u> he said, "Go as fast as you can to every street and alley in town! <u>Bring in everyone</u> <u>who is poor or paralyzed or blind or lame</u>." 22 When the servant returned, he

said, "Master, I've done what you told me, and there is still plenty of room for more people." 23 His master then told him, "<u>Go out along the back roads and</u> <u>make people come in</u>, so my house will be full. 24 Not one of the guests I first invited will get even a bite of my food!"

THREE CALLS TO THE FEAST:

- 1. Them that were invited *the Jews.*
- 2. The poor or paralyzed or blind or lame *the Gentiles.*
- 3. Yet there is room Go out along the back roads *last days revival!*

3:7 God treated me with kindness. <u>His power worked in me</u>, and it became my job to spread the good news.

• Paul is referring to the miraculous moment of his conversion.

3:8 <u>I am the least important of all God's people</u>. But God was kind and <u>chose me</u> <u>to tell the Gentiles</u> that because of Christ there are blessings that cannot be measured.

- I am the least important of all God's people.
- Paul stood in awe that God would save a murderer of Christians.
- And call him to be an Apostle! (We must decrease)

1 Corinthians 15:9 - For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

1 Timothy 1:15 - This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that <u>Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners</u>, of whom I am chief.

3:9 God, who <u>created everything</u>, <u>wanted me</u> to <u>help everyone understand the</u> <u>mysterious plan that had always been hidden in his mind</u>.

Revelation of the church hidden in the OT, but <u>even Gentiles who obeyed were</u> <u>blessed</u>.

"Created everything" – the same God who <u>brought a WORLD out of nothing</u> brings <u>His CHURCH out of nothing</u>!

John 1:3 <u>All things were made through Him</u>, and without Him <u>nothing</u> was made that was made.

3:10 His intent was that now, **through the church**, <u>the manifold wisdom of God</u> <u>should be made known</u> to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms,

• "the intent that NOW" – <u>what was hidden before</u> is revealed <u>NOW.</u>

God <u>always reveals</u> Himself, <u>His principles</u>, and <u>His purposes</u> *progressively in* <u>stages</u>.

You <u>couldn't</u> take it all at once, <u>that's why God waited</u> until NOW in your life. With God, <u>timing is everything</u> – catch His "proceeding" Word!

Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by **every word that proceeds** (continually) from the mouth of God."

Isaiah 55:11 so is <u>my word that goes</u> (continually) out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

When God says something, **His Word continues to work**; the same Word that <u>delivered you</u> still says "**YOU SHALL LIVE...**"

3:11 God did this according to his <u>eternal plan</u>. And he was able to do what he had planned because of **all Christ Jesus our Lord** <u>had done</u>.

"Eternal purpose" – what happens to you as a child of God in TIME was predestined in ETERNITY –

- God didn't just redeem you in TIME, but in ETERNITY
- Rev. 13:8 "the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."

GOD <u>FIXED IT</u> IN ETERNITY, AND THEN <u>MANIFESTED IT</u> IN TIME.

That's why it is only "a matter of time" <u>before God brings me out of my trouble</u> because <u>He fixed it</u> in eternity!

3:12 in Him we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

- "Boldness and access with confidence" "by the faith OF HIM" we live <u>by</u> <u>HIS FAITH</u>!
- **By faith** we can enter <u>directly into God's presence</u> through prayer.
- **Don't** be afraid of God. **He wants to** hear from you!!

Galatians 2:20 I have died, but Christ lives in me. And I now live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave his life for me.

<u>The only thing still alive</u> when Jesus went into the tomb was the words He had spoken <u>BY FAITH</u>.

Many times, <u>our faith and confidence</u> in the Word <u>is all we have</u> when we are <u>buried in our trials</u>!

And <u>without the resurrection</u> of Jesus, we would have no proof that "His faith" worked.

John 2:19 Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and <u>I will raise it again</u> in three days."

1 Corinthians 15:17 <u>Unless Christ was raised to life</u>, your faith is useless, and you are still living in your sins.

3:13 This is why <u>you should not be discouraged</u> when I suffer for you. After all, <u>it</u> <u>will bring honor to you</u>.

<u>If Paul had not preached the gospel</u>, he would <u>not</u> be in jail... but then <u>the</u> <u>Ephesians</u> would not have <u>heard the Good News</u> & <u>come to Jesus either</u>....

- <u>Tribulation for the gospel's sake</u> brings glory to God and to His church –
- Your tribulations are <u>not</u> only for you <u>your experiences impact others</u>.

2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light and <u>momentary troubles</u> are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

We are not going from battle to battle and from trial to trial,

- But we are going from *revelation to revelation*,
- from *victory to victory*, and from *glory to glory*!

2 Timothy 1:8 - <u>Not</u> Ashamed of the Gospel - Therefore <u>do not be ashamed</u> of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but <u>share with me in the sufferings</u> <u>for the gospel</u> according to the power of God,

2 Timothy 2:9 for which I am suffering even to the point of <u>being chained like a</u> <u>criminal</u>. **But God's word is not chained.**

You can't do anything in your own strength that has eternal benefits anyway!

3:14 For this reason I kneel before the father,

• "for this cause I bow" – <u>Paul is in awe</u> of <u>the plan of God</u>

3:15 <u>All beings</u> in heaven and on earth <u>receive their life</u> from him.

- "The whole family" <u>the church is bigger than</u> North America
- The church is also **bigger than NOW**.
- It reaches to the PAST and the FUTURE...
- The whole family *includes an innumerable host of* saints, and even the angels.
- REMEMBER THAT YOU HAVE <u>NEVER WORSHIPPED ALONE</u>!

Hebrews 12:1 - A Large Crowd of Witnesses - Such a large crowd of witnesses is all around us! So we must get rid of everything that slows us down, especially the sin that just won't let go. And <u>we must be determined</u> to run the race that is ahead of us.

God knows <u>how to use</u> what we do and say today to bless someone around the world – or even someone in "the whole family" in a future generation!

3:16 That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit *in the inner man*

 "Inner MAN" – <u>not</u> "inner child" – you are called to be <u>MATURE</u>, strengthened by God to be <u>MATURE</u>, and expected to be <u>MATURE</u>!

3:17 that Christ may <u>dwell</u> in your hearts through faith; that you, being <u>rooted</u> and grounded in love,

- "dwell" <u>this means that Christ is not</u> just living in our hearts, but that <u>He</u> <u>is</u> "feeling at home" in us!
- "Rooted and grounded" <u>securely fixed</u>!

3:18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.

3:19 and to know <u>this love that surpasses knowledge</u>—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

"surpasses knowledge" – <u>greater than</u> what you can figure out!

There is <u>no dysfunction</u> in a child **who knows** <u>that they are truly loved</u> – **God's love dispels our dependence** <u>on others for our happiness</u>.

3:20 Now to him who can do <u>immeasurably more than all</u> we ask or imagine, <u>according</u> to his power that is at work within us,

"*Immeasurably more than all*" – English translators are struggling a bit here to give us the sense that **God's power is** "<u>over the top</u>"

"according" - common word in Ephesians, meaning "in harmony with" -

In the first two chapters refers to something God or the devil did (in spirit realm) – **Here it is used to refer to something that** *<u>WE as the church allow</u>! Hallelujah!!!*

3:21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

"Amen" – "absolutely, unequivocally true" – you can't argue with a statement that has an "Amen" at the end of it!

CLOSE:

2 Corinthians 1:20 For no matter how many *promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ.* And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.

Romans 16:20 <u>The God of peace</u> will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you. Amen.

Revelation 22:20 I Am Coming Quickly - He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
