## Having Compassion And Making A Difference

General Purpose: Motivation towards Evangelism Connections:

Angle: A fresh word from God can make the difference in your walk Purpose: To encourage people to notice those around them and influence there lives

Context: The book of Jude has a strong warning against false teachings that crept into the church

Jude 1:16-25 - A Call to Persevere - <sup>16</sup> These are grumblers, complainers, walking according to their own lusts; and they mouth great swelling *words*, flattering people to gain advantage. <sup>17</sup> But you, beloved, <u>remember the words which were</u> <u>spoken before by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>: <sup>18</sup> how they told you that there would be mockers in the last time who would walk according to their own ungodly lusts. <sup>19</sup> These are sensual persons, who cause divisions, <u>not having the Spirit</u>.

Maintain Your Life with God - <sup>20</sup> But you, beloved, <u>building yourselves up</u> on your most holy faith, <u>praying in the Holy Spirit</u>, <sup>21</sup> <u>keep yourselves in the love of</u> <u>God</u>, <u>looking for the mercy</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. <sup>22</sup> <u>And some</u> <u>have compassion, making a distinction</u>; <sup>23</sup> but others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.

**Glory to God** - <sup>24</sup> <u>Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling</u>, and to present *you* faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, <sup>25</sup> To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, *Be* glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen.

# Written A.D. 67,68 probably in Jerusalem The Spiritual thought: He is able!

Context of the book:

- Jude describes <u>false teachers who deny the Lord</u> and give a license to sin.
- He points out <u>their principles</u> and <u>practices</u> and gives O.T. illustrations of <u>sins leading to apostasy</u>.

Apostasy, the total rejection of Christianity by a baptized person who, having at one time professed the Christian faith, publicly rejects it.

- Israel's-<u>unbelief</u>
- Angels-*rebellion*
- Sodom and Gomorrah-immorality
- Cain-self will
- Balaam-*covetousness*
- Korah-rejection of God's authority

**Summary**: Jude sums up the awfulness of their sins and concludes that - <sup>19</sup> These are sensual people, who cause divisions, <u>not having the Spirit</u>.

• Believers are strongly encouraged to recognize their calling.

The Name "Jude" means "he shall be praised."

#### Intro Thought:

Jude 1:17 - But you, beloved, <u>remember the words which were spoken before by</u> the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ:

**Contend for the Faith – Jude 1:3** - Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to **contend earnestly for the faith** which was once for all **delivered** to the saints.

#### Remember the words of the Apostles:

- Earnestly contend: Like an athlete who strives to victory
- **The Faith**: The sound doctrine, the truth of the gospel
- **Delivered**: The gospel that was approved and authorized by the apostles

Maintain Your Life with God – Jude1:20-21 But you, beloved, <u>building yourselves</u> <u>up</u> on your most holy faith, <u>praying in the Holy Spirit</u>, <sup>21</sup><u>keep yourselves in the</u> <u>love of God</u>, <u>looking for the mercy</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Building yourselves on your most holy faith: This is a reference to the freshness of doctrine, not the fruit of the Spirit. *"Building" is a community effort.* 

**Christ Our Cornerstone – Eph. 2:19-22** Now, therefore, you are <u>no longer</u> <u>strangers and foreigners</u>, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, <sup>20</sup> <u>having been built on the foundation of the apostles and</u> <u>prophets</u>, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, <sup>21</sup> in whom <u>the whole</u> **building, being fitted together**, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, <sup>22</sup> in whom **you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God** in the Spirit.

• Looking for mercy: Stand watch, be sober.

# A. THE SPIRIT WORKING WITH YOU MAKES THE DIFFERENCE:

Mark 16:20 - Then <u>the disciples went out</u> and <u>preached everywhere</u>, and <u>the Lord</u> <u>worked with them</u> and <u>confirmed his word</u> by the <u>signs that accompanied it</u>.

Seed Thought: When we read the word of God and study out the gospels, there were 12 ordinary men who were trained and discipled under the wing of Jesus.

- They took the gospel message of saving grace, "Having compassion."
- Within them and shook the world around them "Making A difference."

# 1. <u>the disciples went out</u> = How did they get the passion?

Acts 1:9 - Jesus Ascends to Heaven - Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.

- (We need to receive our glimpse of glory)
- 2. Preached everywhere = *That was their lifestyle*, that is <u>what was taught by</u> <u>Jesus himself</u>.
- 3. The Lord working with them = To be a fellow worker, We've got the power, use your prayer tool "In the name of Jesus"
  - In the name of Jesus, you can bind that Spirit.
  - In the name of Jesus, you can command that spirit to come out.
  - In the name of Jesus, you can receive your miracle.
  - In the name of Jesus, **be healed.**
  - In the name of Jesus, receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
  - It's in the name of Jesus, we receive the forgiveness of sins.
  - It's in the name of Jesus that makes all the difference!
- 4. Confirming the word with <u>signs</u> following = Miracles will follow!

Personal Application: We have the opportunity and are given the ability to make a difference in those that are around us.

#### **B. TIMOTHY MAKES A DIFFERENCE:**

1 Timothy 4:12 - Take Heed to Your Ministry - <u>Let no one despise your youth</u>, but <u>be an example to the believers</u> in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

1 Timothy 4:16 - <u>Take heed</u> to yourself and to the doctrine. <u>Continue in them</u>, for in doing this you will <u>save both yourself and those who hear you</u>.

- In Word: The doctrine
- **Conversation:** Behavior/lifestyle
- In charity: Love and how you treat others.
- In Faith: Your commitment to the work of God
- **Purity:** Holiness

Take heed (Take a hold) of the doctrine and make a difference in teaching and winning souls!

C. GOD PRESERVES, MAKES THE DIFFERENCE:

Jude 1:1 – Jude, <u>a bondservant of Jesus Christ</u>, and brother of James,

To those who are called, *sanctified* by God the Father, and *preserved* in Jesus Christ:

The definition of the Greek word for sanctified means "to love in a social or moral sense."

Jude 1:1 NIV To those who have been called, who are loved by God the Father and kept by Jesus Christ:

*If you're tired* of your life hitting a dead-end street, your sins shackled around your feet, trying to break that drug habit, *let the Spirit of God move on you*.

• It will make all the difference in your life!

**Personal**: I'm standing here years later, I haven't had drink, smoked any dope, or done any drugs. *It's the Spirit of God working in my life that keeps me "preserved"* 

D. THE SPIRIT WORKING WITH YOU MAKES THE DIFFERENCE:

Having Jesus in your life makes all the difference:

- You'll have a relationship that can <u>never be abolished.</u>
- A righteousness that can never be tarnished.
- An acceptance that can never be questioned.
- A standing that can never be shaken.
- A justification that can never be reversed.
- A seal that can never be broken.
- An inheritance that can never be alienated.
- A wealth that can never be depleted.
- A possession that can never be measured.
- A strength that can never <u>be weakened</u>.

**Psalm 18:2** - The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.

#### E. WHAT MAKES THE DIFFERENCE IN A CHURCH SERVICE?

#### Instructions for the church:

#### There is a difference between religion and a relationship with God!

• Coming to church for prayer and having a prayer meeting, hearing a sermon, or hearing the preached word of God is one thing.....

**BUT Having the fire, the power, and anointing makes all the difference** - between having <u>dry, dull, boring</u> church or having the flood gates of heaven pouring out the Holy Spirit and having revival!

Ps 134:2 - Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the LORD.

**Ps 107:1** - <u>O give thanks unto the LORD</u>, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

**Ps 47:1** - <u>O clap your hands</u>, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.

Ps 100:1 - Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

**Ps 149:3** - Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.

**Ps 56:4 -** In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

#### F. JOHN THE BAPTIST

Luke 3:16 - John answered, saying to all, "I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. <u>He</u> will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

- 1. He was "The man sent from God."
- 2. <u>He would have</u> the spirit and power of Elijah.
- 3. <u>He preached</u> *"Repent, the kingdom of heaven is at hand."*
- 4. <u>He preached</u> "And all flesh shall see the salvation of God."
- 5. <u>He preached</u> "He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire.
- HE HAD THE BOLDNESS OF ISAIAH, THE PASSION OF JEREMIAH AND THE ANNOINTING OF ELIJAH
- HE WAS A VOICE, NOT AN ECHO, MAKING A DIFFERENCE!

## G. CLOSING THOUGHTS:

Jesus has compassion!

- **On the crowd** with no shepherd: Matt 9:36
- All that were sick among the crowd: Matt 14:14
- The crowd that had no food: Matt 15:32
- The healing of the 2 blind men Matt 20:34
- The leper with the withered hand: Mark 1:41
- The man with the legion of demons: Mark 5:19
- The widow whose son died: Luke 7:13

Jesus made the ultimate difference at Calvary by going to the cross and dying for our sins.
