#### **BREAKING FREE FROM THE PAST**

In this series of messages, we have been looking at **how we can <u>completely break free</u>**From our past, so that we can live <u>successful and productive lives</u> now!!!!!!

## Living in the past is killing your future!!!!!!!

• You can't drive forward staring into the rear-view mirror...

In this message today I want to share with you,

- That <u>life is actually designed</u> to be **full of <u>hardships</u>**....
- To the degree that we have <u>successfully let go</u> of the past
- The more prepared we will be to deal with the present.

<u>Matthew 6:34</u> - Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

- **Planning for tomorrow** is <u>time well spent</u>...
- Worrying about tomorrow is <u>time wasted</u>....
- Careful planning is thinking ahead and trusting God's guidance!!!!!
- Worriers, by contrast, are consumed by fear. Find it very difficult to trust God!

## When Something bad happens in our lives we have 3 choices!!!!

- 1. Let it define us...
- 2. Let it destroy us....
- 3. Let it <u>determine</u> us!!!!!!
- We <u>cannot allow</u> Hardship's to <u>define or destroy us</u>, we <u>can</u> let them <u>**DETERMINE US!!!!!**</u>

Considering <u>my past</u> circumstances, my <u>current</u> situation and <u>my future</u> hopes & dreams, what is the wise thing to do? <u>I choose!</u>

• To live in victory **NOT** as a victim!!!!!

Many people have <u>a hard time dealing with</u> the <u>struggles in their lives</u> because,

- They are too busy fretting (visibly worried) about <u>the future</u>.
- *Their future* is tainted with the <u>failure and the problems of the past</u>....
- As a result, they are <u>immobilized</u> in their ability to function now.

#### Therefore:

I want to share with you today, The importance of finding joy in life's hardships!

#### HARDSHIPS & TROUBLES ARE A NECESSARY PART OF LIFE.

#### Helen Keller once said:

We could never learn to be brave and patient, if there were only joy in the world.

#### As I begin this message today,

It's important for us to acknowledge that <u>hardships</u>, <u>trials</u>, <u>tribulations</u>, and <u>troubles</u> are a necessary part of life.

**John 16:33** "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

- Jesus tells his disciples here to take courage....
- In spite of the inevitable struggles they would face....
- They would not be alone!!!!!

#### Jesus does not abandon us to our struggles either...

- The ultimate victory has already been won...
- **WE can** claim the **peace** of Christ.
- *In* the most troublesome times!!!!!

## In the world we will have tribulations and troubles: =

<u>sicknesses</u>, <u>family tragedies</u>, <u>out of work</u>, <u>financial difficulties</u>, <u>family problems</u>, <u>major calamities</u> - <u>tornados</u>, <u>floods</u>, <u>business failure</u>.....

It is a given, but Jesus says, "be of good cheer".

He is saying that we must learn how to find joy during life's hardships,

• Because **He has overcome** the world!!!!!!

# James tells us to count all of this joy:

James 1:2-4 - My brethren, <u>count it all joy</u> when you fall into <u>various trials</u>, knowing that <u>the testing of your faith produces patience</u>. But let patience have its **perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing**.

# How many of us really take this verse seriously?

• We laugh and say, "Yea o sure uh huh!"

The truth is, if we really desire the liberating power of God's Spirit and kingdom in our lives, we must find joy in life's hardships.

Mother Teresa once said: JOY is: a net of love by which you can catch souls!!!

In this message today: I want to give you three reasons why, we need to learn how to enjoy life's hardships!!!!!

## 1. The Storms of Life Help Keep Us On Track With God

**Psalms 119:67 -** Before I was afflicted, <u>I went astray</u>, But now I keep Your word.

There's a story of a woman who became the victim of amnesia.

- For <u>three months</u> she wandered, But during a severe thunderstorm <u>she suddenly</u> remembered who **she was... & where she was from.**
- A Cleveland, Ohio, police officer said that the storm jolted her memory back!!!!

## How often the storms of life bring us back to our senses!

- God sends them not to destroy us but to help us.
- Many people can **look back** and thank God.....
- For the storms that brought them back to Him!!!!!!!

## 2. It Takes Hardship for God's Kingdom To Fully Emerge In Our Lives

It takes the pressure and struggle that comes through these hardships,

- For the kingdom of God to fully emerge And overpower the kingdom of darkness.
- Struggles and hardships bring forth a clashing of kingdoms...
- Which <u>fully releases</u> the power of the kingdom of God!!!!!

Paul and Barnabas return to visit the believers in the cities...

• Where they had been previously threatened and physically attacked!!!!

**Acts 14:22** - strengthening the disciples and encouraging them to remain true to the faith. "We must **go through many hardships** to enter the kingdom of God," they said.

- They **knew** the dangers yet....
- They had to <u>encourage the believers</u>....
- No matter how inconvenient or uncomfortable it may be...
- Our job is to encourage new believers....
- It was <u>NOT</u> convenient or comfortable <u>for Jesus</u> to go to the cross for us!!!!!

# Are you congratulating yourself <u>on having an easy time in life</u> with <u>no hardships or</u> difficulties to bear?

• Then **beware**, that you don't perish miserably **in defeat**."

## One of the biggest questions a Christian may ask is,

- If I am a Christian, and God loves me and protects me,
- <u>WHY</u> am I going through hardship and tough times?

#### It is important to know that God does not say,

• That as Christians we are going to live happy and perfect lives!!!!!

#### In fact, HE through Paul says quite the opposite:

**Philippians 1:28-29** - without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved—and that by God.

<sup>29</sup> For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him,

- Paul considers it a privilege to suffer for Christ....
- We do not by nature consider suffering a privilege!

## Paul lists all of HIS sufferings and hardship's in:

**2 Corinthians 11:22-28** - <sup>22</sup> Are they Hebrews? So am I. Are they Israelites? So am I. Are they Abraham's descendants? So am I. <sup>23</sup> Are they servants of Christ? (I am out of my mind to talk like this.) I am more. I have worked much harder, been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and been exposed to death again and again. <sup>24</sup> Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. <sup>25</sup> Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, <sup>26</sup> I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers. <sup>27</sup> I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked. <sup>28</sup> Besides everything else, I face daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches.

- The question is therefore why do we suffer for Christ?
- How do we deal with it?????

#### 3. Struggles And Hardships Sift Out The Impurities In Our Lives

*Hebrews 12:27-28* - <sup>27</sup> The words "once more" indicate <u>the removing</u> of what can be shaken—that is, <u>created things</u>—so that <u>what cannot be shaken may remain</u>.

<sup>28</sup> Therefore, since <u>we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken</u>, let us <u>be thankful</u>, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe,

A Christian man **lost his home and mill** when a flood washed them away.

- He was brokenhearted and discouraged as he stood surveying his loss.
- Just then he saw a glittering object that had been uncovered by the waters.
- It was gold!

The disaster he thought had made him a beggar had actually made him wealthy.

- The Lord often works through our troubles
- To strip away certain cherished possessions
- To show us *the better treasures* of *His love and power*.
- How thankful we should be that in <u>every storm of affliction</u>.
- We have the assurance That the Lord has a good purpose in view!

- 1. Whine about it....
- 2. Lower your expectations to match YOUR abilities...
- 3. Take your next step by faith.....

The more joy we are able to find in the midst of life's hardships.

- The <u>stronger and more secure</u> we will be as individuals,
- Who are now able to walk in victory and succeeding in the issues of life.

Nehemiah 8:10 - This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, <u>for the joy of the Lord is your strength.</u>"

## It all boils down to the fact that hardships are a part of life!

- And there is **no way we can escape** them in our lives.
- They serve a meaningful purpose,
- So, we might as well **learn how to enjoy them** rather than fighting against them.
- We will be much happier and stronger as a result.
- 1. The storms of life help keep us on track!
- 2. It takes hardships for God's Kingdom to fully emerge in our lives!
- 3. Struggles and Hardships sift out the impurities in our lives!

Today you may be facing some of these Hardships.

- Something bad has happened to you....
- Don't Let it DETERMINE YOU TODAY!!!!!!

Come face to face with your limitations here at the altar...

- **DON'T** whine or lower you expectation...
- TAKE your next step of FAITH!!!!!!

DON'T sorrow any longer (Nehemiah 8:10)
